SYNOPSIS OF ARREST

On October 10, 2019 at approximately 0524 hours, Officer Colt Bruhl was stationary in Crossover #3 monitoring northbound traffic and observed a Gray GMC Acadia (LA/797CBC) traveling northbound in the right lane near the 15.4 mile marker at a high rate of speed, which was confirmed 93mph in a 65mph zone via front stationary radar (KC126015). Ofc. Bruhl further stated that as the vehicle passed the crossover, he heard the sound of the vehicle repeatedly striking the reflectors on the centerline of the roadway. Ofc. Bruhl exited the crossover and caught up with the vehicle as it slowed down near Crossover #1. After the vehicle passed Crossover #1, Ofc. Bruhl observed the vehicle abruptly accelerate and reach 108mph in a 65mph zone confirmed via front moving radar (KC126015). Ofc. Bruhl observed the vehicle having difficulty remaining in its lane of travel, swerving and striking the centerline on multiple occasions. A traffic stop was conducted at the T.P.N. Shoulder. Ofc. Bruhl advised that upon making personal contact with the driver, later identified as Gregory Longino (LA/[REDACTED]) that he observed that Longino had glassy and blood shot eyes, slurred speech and a moderate odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath and person.

I, Officer Christian Coyle, also made personal contact with Longino and observed that he had glassy and blood shot eyes, slurred speech and a moderate odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath and person. Ofc. Bruhl asked Longino how much alcohol he'd consumed and Longino advised that he'd only consumed a beer. Longino advised officers that they should know who he was. Longino went on to state that he was the Chief Deputy of the St. Tammany Sheriff's Office. Longino willingly performed Standardized Field Sobriety Tests with poor results. Longino was placed under arrest (placed in handcuffs, checked for proper fit and double locked) and read his Constitutional Rights. While being read his Constitutional Rights, Longino repeatedly interrupted and reminded officers of his status with the sheriff's office. Longino then repeatedly asked if the arresting officers were going to take him to "his jail".

Longino was subsequently transported to LSP Troop L, and at 0610 hours were he was read his

SYNOPSIS OF ARREST

Rights Relating to the Chemical Test for Intoxication. At 0632 hours, he was offered the state's intoxilyzer breath test and refused to provide a proper breath sample. Longino advised that he would submit to a blood specimen and signed all appropriate documentation accordingly. Longino then willingly provided a blood specimen for further chemical analysis, which was collected by Paramedic Axel Pitre of the Mandeville Fire Department - Officer Jason Bourne was at LSP Troop L and assisted with packaging the blood specimen kit to be sent off to LSP Crime Lab with results pending. I was advised by Longino at Troop L that he had only taken (2) shots which contradicted his previous statement that he'd only drank a beer when first stopped by officers.

Longino was then transported to St. Tammany Parish Jail where he was booked relative to LA RS 14:98 DWI 1st Offense, LA RS 32:58 Careless Operation and LA RS 32:63A Speeding 108MPH/65MPH zone. Longino was released to jail personnel in good health without further incident.

Longino's vehicle was released to Captain Michael Ferrell (St. Tammany S.O District III Commander) at his (Longino's) request.
