On 09/07/2018 at approximately 10:55pm Officers E. Vasquez and L. Carrasquillo were flagged down on Main St. for a report of a larceny.

The victim, who was identified as [REDACTED], SS# [REDACTED] stated that her purse was stolen in the casino. Officers Vasquez and Carrasquillo began to speak with Ms. [REDACTED] while they contacted State Police Trooper D. Oliver, Officer Cotto and myself, Officer S. Clark, who are assigned to the Gaming Enforcement Unit.

The female stated that she was in the area of the walk up bar inside the casino walking near the slots. She stated she put her purse down at an unknown location. I contacted MGM Security to check their lost and found department. The purse was located in the lost and found. When Ms. [REDACTED] looked through the purse and stated her cell phone, a black Iphone 7 valued at \$500, was no longer in the purse.

MGM surveillance reviewed the video and observed Ms. [REDACTED] as she put her purse down in the area of the slots. MGM surveillance showed a [REDACTED] male wearing a blue shirt, a grey baseball hat, dark shorts and Jordan sneakers. The surveillance showed the male take the purse into the bathroom and leave without it. Later an unknown party turned the purse in to security. The phone was traced via a 'Friend Finder' app to be in the area of School St. and Myrtle St. Metro Officers played the area but were unable to locate the male.

On 09-20-18 Ofc. M. Lee was working his assignment with the MA Gaming Commission at the MGM Casino on a 3p-1a shift. Ofc. Lee was on the casino floor at about 20:30 hrs when approached by swing shift manager [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] asked Ofc. Lee to assist with a customer who was suspected of cheating on roulette table R0509. The suspect, later identified [REDACTED], had left the table and walked to the mens room on west side of the casino floor. [REDACTED] reported the subject was a [REDACTED] male with black hair and a red polo shirt. After a brief moment the subject matching the description and pointed out by [REDACTED] exited the mens room and Ofc. Lee and Ofc. Rodriguez detained the subject and went to the MA Gaming Commission office on the property.

Ofc. Lee was in contact with the surveillance unit of MGM about the incident involving Mr [REDACTED]. Surveillance reported observing more than one incident of [REDACTED] past posting bets (placing a wager after the dealer has waved no more bets).

Mr [REDACTED] was informed an investigation was being opened about the events that occurred. Mr [REDACTED] was then trespassed from the property by MGM security.

*Follow up*

Gaming Agent [REDACTED] reviewed surveillance tapes of Mr [REDACTED] and observed the following:  
On 09-20-18 Mr [REDACTED] was in the casino floor when the listed events occurred:

14:38 hrs. [REDACTED] places a bet on the courtesy line on table roulette R0506. Just prior to the ball dropping the number being established [REDACTED] purposely splashes chips in his hand on the gaming table. As [REDACTED] clears his chips he picks up the bet he had placed, he pinches the bet ( when chips are pulled off the table when its clear the number is not a winning number and after the dealer has waved no more bets and table is frozen )

18:16 [REDACTED] is observed telling the dealer he had a corner bet, that he did not have and receives \$40. The dealer had cleared the table was before paying out any winnings [REDACTED] argues his chip was wrongly pulled off the table. The video clearly show there was no chip on the bet line.

19:32 [REDACTED] past posted 2 chips and received \$350.00 pay out. (past posted is when chips are placed on a number after the dealer has waived no more bets, and in this occasion the winning number had been established)

19:38 [REDACTED] past posted 2 chips and received \$350.00 pay out. (dealer had waived off no more bets and ball had dropped and established a winning number)

19:45 [REDACTED] past posted 3 chips and received \$525.00 pay out. ([REDACTED] places bet after ball has dropped, dealer [REDACTED] takes off the bet and returns the chips to [REDACTED] immediately places bet back on, and the dealer leaves it)

20:01 [REDACTED] past posted 1 chip and received \$175.00 pay out.

20:07 [REDACTED] argues he convinces dealer he had 1 chip on a split (bet line) that he actually did not have. The dealer had swept and cleared the table of non winning chips. [REDACTED] received \$85.00 pay out.

On 08/29/2018 at approximately 1:15am Officer C. Cotto and I, Officer S. Clark while assigned to the Gaming Enforcement Unit (GEU) responded to an altercation at the MGM casino.

Officer Cotto and I were on a walking patrol of the MGM casino floor when we heard and observed what looked like a disturbance. We ran to the area of the gaming tables where we observed two females were involved in a physical fight. Officer Cotto and I ran to separate the parties. We attempted to stabilize the two parties but were unable to separate them because they were pulling each other by their hair. Cotto and I were issuing verbal commands for the females to stop fighting. Moreover, as Cotto and I were attempting to separate the two we were subsequently hit as the females were reaching for each other. I removed my taser and told the females that if they did not stop fighting they would be tased. One female, upon hearing my order, immediately let go of the female and became compliant. Officer Cotto then gained compliance from the second female.

I escorted one female to the Massachusetts Gaming Commission Office while Officer Cotto escorted the second female to a private area near the Main St. entrance. It should be noted that I was accompanied by Security Staff as well as State Police Trooper P. Kudryk. The female, who identified herself as [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]), explained she was friends with the other female, who was identified by Officer Cotto as [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]). I advised Ms. [REDACTED] on how she could seek her own criminal complaint at the Springfield District Courthouse.
