JUDGING CRITERIA

The WLKY-TV Spirit of Louisville Foundation Board of Trustees will select the Bell Award and Youth Service Honor recipients based on the information provided in this nomination form. The judges consider:

- The average number of hours volunteered
- The diversity of the nominee's volunteer activities
- What defines this nominee as an "outstanding" volunteer
