



2020 Wall of Fame Humanitarian Award Nomination Form

Nomination Deadline: July 31, 2020

The Wall of Fame Humanitarian Awards celebrates public education at its finest, honoring Oklahoma City Public Schools alumni who through their lives have added significantly to our city, state or nation. The 2020 nominees will join 88 other alumni who have been inducted since the Wall of Fame was created in 1985. Over the past 35 years, the Wall of Fame has celebrated the long, rich history of Oklahoma City Public Schools. It includes some of the most influential business, community and artistic leaders throughout the city, country and world.

Criteria for nomination:

1. Must be an OKCPS Alumni:
 - a. Has attended any OKCPS elementary, middle or high school (Being a graduate is preferred, but is not a requirement)
2. Provides outstanding leadership/contributions in the Oklahoma City metropolitan area, such as:
 - a. Strives to bring unity to their community by leading efforts in activism/advocacy
 - b. Serves as a first responder (health care provider, first responder or essential worker) during the COVID-19 pandemic
3. Reflects positively on Oklahoma City Public Schools

Submitting two letters of recommendation is encouraged, but not required.

What is Different In 2020?

This year has proven to be a different year than any of us expected. Because of the global pandemic, special events throughout our community have been changed or cancelled. After careful deliberation, we have decided that holding a gala this year is not the right approach, though we do not want to miss the opportunity to recognize past Wall of Fame Honorees and to recognize a new group of spectacular Oklahoma City Public Schools alumni.

Instead of looking across the country and world for our 2020 Wall of Fame Honorees, we want to look right here in Oklahoma City to recognize OKCPS Alumni making a difference during these challenging times we are facing.

We will not be hosting our traditional Wall of Fame gala in November. Instead, we will select the 2020 honorees and feature them through social media beginning in September. In addition, each honoree will receive our traditional ribbon and medallion and a \$500 cash prize!
