As you are aware, the siren system at Seabrook Station was inadvertently activated during routine testing on July 12. While the situation was addressed within minutes, we regret the ramifications this caused to the residents in our neighboring communities. There were no operating issues at the plant when the sirens were activated.

The Seabrook Station team is conducting a thorough investigation and we will take actions to ensure this situation does not happen again. We are also committed to enhancing our notification and communication to state and local agencies based on our findings.

The siren system is an important element of the emergency response plan for Seabrook Station. The system is tested on a frequent basis to ensure that it is reliable should it be needed to provide notification in an actual emergency.

At Seabrook Station, our top priority is the safety of the people living and working in our neighboring communities.
