Dear Director Stirling:

I am in receipt of an Application for Executive Clemency, dated October 30, 2024 ("Application"), submitted on behalf of the above-referenced inmate. I have carefully reviewed and thoughtfully considered the Application, matters of record, including transcripts, briefs, and judicial decisions, as well as certain additional petitions or informal requests for executive clemency in connection with this matter. I have also spoken with members of Mr. Mahoney's family.

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of South Carolina and pursuant to article IV, section 14 of the South Carolina Constitution and the discretion conferred upon me therein, and consistent with my contemporaneous oral transmission of my decision to you, this letter shall memorialize and further confirm that I have declined to grant executive clemency in this matter. Accordingly, unless stayed by order of a court of competent jurisdiction, the execution shall proceed in accordance with section 17-25-370 of the South Carolina Code of Laws and the Supreme Court of South Carolina's October 4, 2024 Execution Notice.
