Solid Waste Inspector Melanie Glenn and I arrived at the facility and met with Nick Oster and Facility Manager Shaun Preston. The amount of chipped material onsite has been substantially reduced since the previous inspection, and signs have been placed in order to help with the organization of materials. Logs still line the road to the entrance of the facility. The super silt fence separating the property from the Jones Falls River is compromised due to some logs falling onto the fence. The fire lane for the logs along the road is blocked by a fallen log but is otherwise clear.

Summary: The accumulation of land clearing debris and natural wood waste without timely processing or removal constitutes “open dumping”. Follow-up with the facility manager is needed; a schedule for the removal of all unprocessed materials that have been stockpiled on site for over a year should be established.

Note: Operating without a permit or in violation of a permit or law may result in the assessment of civil or administrative penalties. *Each day a violation occurs is a separate occurrence.* Be advised that this inspection report is a public record and as such, is accessible to the public.
