Remarks:

I arrived at the facility and began my inspection by taking pictures of the access road. I did not observe any logs dumped along the access road. I observed a large area graded with mulch where the logs used to be dumped. I observed a small pile of waste full of material previously observed buried in the mulch near the access road. I arrived at the sawmill and met with Shaun Preston and La-Lonnie in the office. Mr. Preston stated that all of the dumped logs have been grinded and removed, with the remaining mulch piles onsite scheduled to be removed. Mr. Preston stated that all of the remaining mulch piles will be removed, the property will be graded with mulch, and a perimeter fence will be installed with a swing gate based on the contract. Mr. Preston stated that the project is scheduled to be completed by the end of July 2025.

Summary: Non-compliant with COMAR 26.04.07.03. and COMAR 26.04.09.03., Site Complaint SC-O-25-NW-001 remains open for the ongoing violations.
