SLED Will Not Investigate Mauldin Police

MAULDIN, SC – The State Law Enforcement Division informed the City of Mauldin that it will not investigate the Mauldin Police Department. The agency said it found no actions that rose to a level of criminality by the City or its Police Department personnel regarding the reported inappropriate activities. SLED's determination on this matter was reached following its review of the internal investigation and the facts of this case and consulting with prosecutors.

While the actions of the former employees of our Police Department violated the City's personnel code and did not adhere to our standards, as confirmed by SLED's review, they were not criminal.

Mayor Raines stated that “while the inappropriate actions of seven City employees has garnered a great deal of attention we should not overlook all the other dedicated, professional employees across all departments in the city that continue to provide excellent customer service in their daily routines.” The City values the members of its hardworking Police Department. Please be assured that we are committed to providing excellent law enforcement services.
