Before me, MARY P. BERSAN Clerk of the District/Circuit Court of Lee County, Alabama, personally appeared

Sgt. Kevin J. Freeze (on behalf of Aniah Haley Blanchard)

Who being first duly sworn, deposes and says on oath, that he had probable cause for believing and does believe that

Antwain Shamar Fisher, alias, "Squirmy", alias

did abduct another person with intent to hold him or her for ransom or reward, use him or her as a shield or hostage, accomplish or aid the commission of a felony or flight therefrom, inflict physical injury upon or to violate him or her sexually, terrorize him or her or a third person, or interfere with the performance of any governmental or political function, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

Probable Cause:

On or about October 24, 2019, Auburn Police met with family members of Aniah Haley Blanchard, alias, in reference to a missing person complaint. Blanchard was last seen by a family member the evening of October 23, 2019, at a residence in the [REDACTED] Auburn, Lee County, Alabama. The victim's vehicle, a black 2017 Honda CRV bearing Alabama license 49BS356 and VIN 5J6RW5H32HL004086, was later located abandoned in Montgomery, Alabama. Blood evidence was discovered in the passenger's compartment of the vehicle that was indicative of someone suffering a life-threatening injury. The evidence was submitted to the Alabama Department of Forensic Sciences and confirmed to be that of Aniah Blanchard. Video evidence from a convenience store located at 1599 South College Street, Auburn, Lee County, Alabama placed both Blanchard and a black male, later positively identified as Ibraheem Yazeed, alias at the store during the same time; this was the last time she was seen. During the subsequent investigation a witness identified Yazeed as the individual he observed forcing Blanchard into a vehicle against her will and then leaving with her in the vehicle. Blanchard has not been located at this time.

Further investigation revealed that Antwain Shamar Fisher, alias, "Squirmy", alias, provided material assistance to Yazeed by providing transportation to Yazeed, and disposing of evidence.
