The Court further finds that the defendant in this cause shall compensate Hinds County in the amount of \$.00 for expenses of appointed counsel.

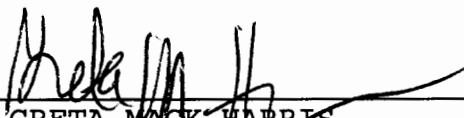
