On September 15th, 2022, Governor Ron DeSantis sent two planes full of migrants from Venezuela to Martha's Vineyard. According to a statement from the governor's office:

"Florida can confirm the two planes with illegal immigrants that arrived in Martha's Vineyard today were part of the state's relocation program to transport illegal immigrants to sanctuary destinations."

Pursuant to the Public Records Act, Chapter 119 of the Florida Statutes, I am requesting the following information from the Governor's Office related to Florida's relocation program to send migrants out of state:

- All requests for proposals and contracts associated with the state relocation program to transport migrants.
- All emails, texts, other forms of internal communications within the Governor's office related to the relocation program.
- All emails, texts, and other forms of internal communications between the Governor's office and the Florida Department of Transportation related to the relocation program.

I am also requesting any and all documents pertaining to the state's relocation program to transfer migrants.

Finally, I am requesting all communication between Governor DeSantis' office and the office of Massachusetts Governor Charlie Baker related to the relocation program.

Should you deny my request, or any part of the request, please state in writing the basis for the denial, including the exact statutory citation authorizing the denial as required by s. 119.07(1)(d), F.S.
