Incident Summary

On 19DEC25 at 9:00 pm, USCG Sector St. Petersburg received a report for a 42FT Vessel (UNSTOPP-A-BULL) overdue from a fishing trip with 02 Persons on board.

Randall Spivey and Brandon Billmaier departed from their residence near Fort Myers and were set to arrive back to the same location at sunset the same day.

USCG Sector St. Petersburg issued an Urgent Marine Information Broadcast and launched an MH-60 helicopter.

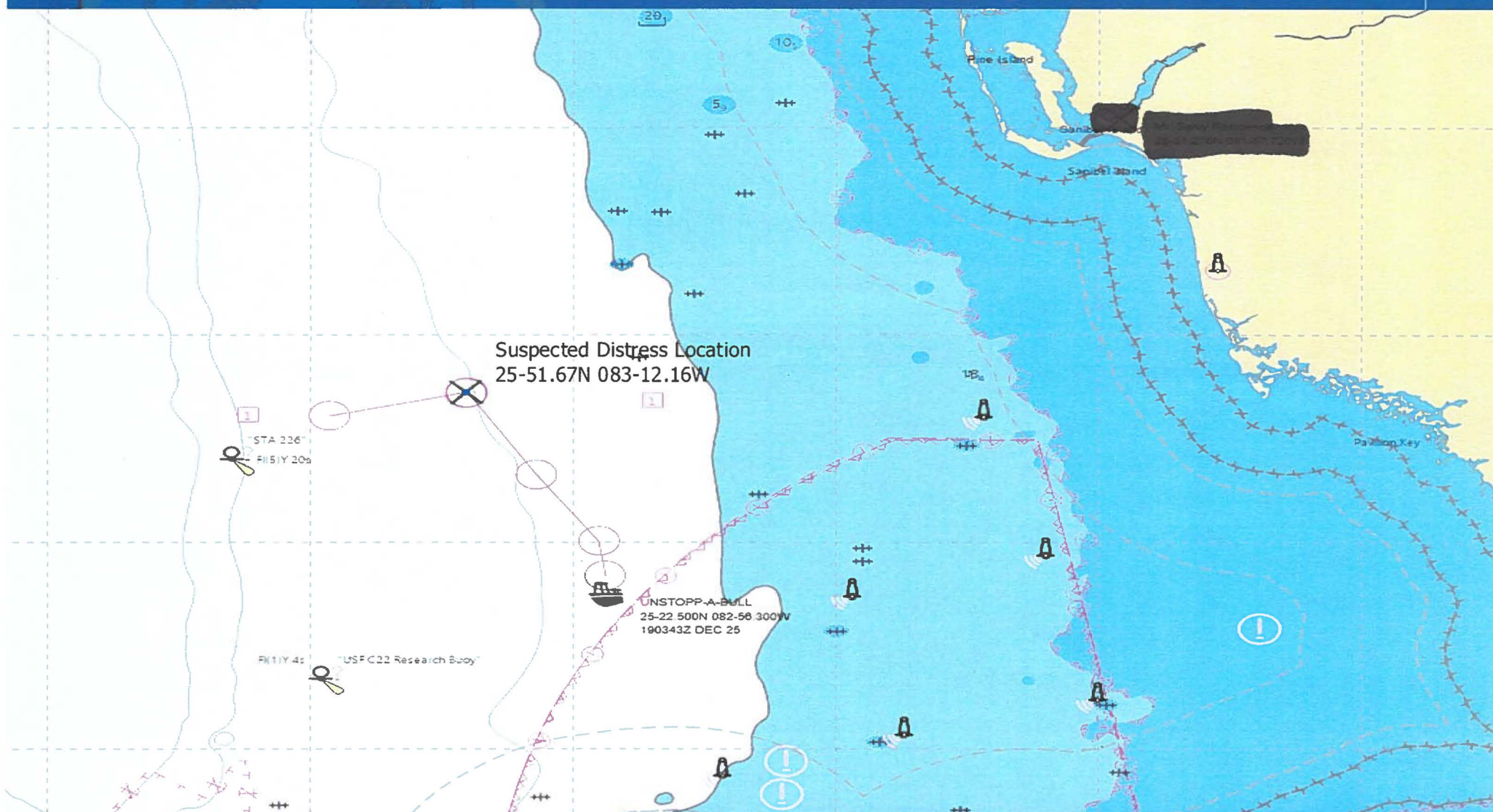
At 12:12 am, CGR6064 located the UNSTOPP-A-BULL approx. 70NM Southwest of Naples, FL with no one located onboard.

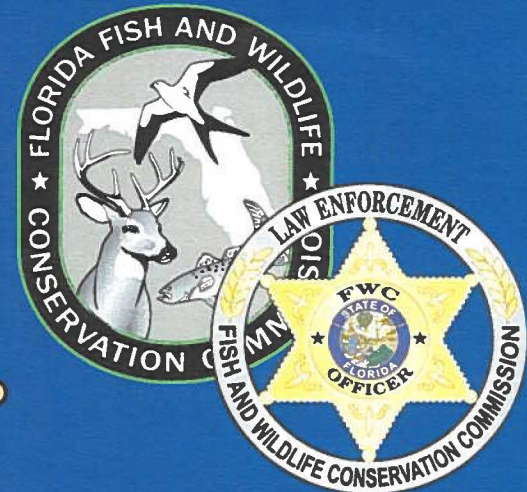

Description of Search Efforts

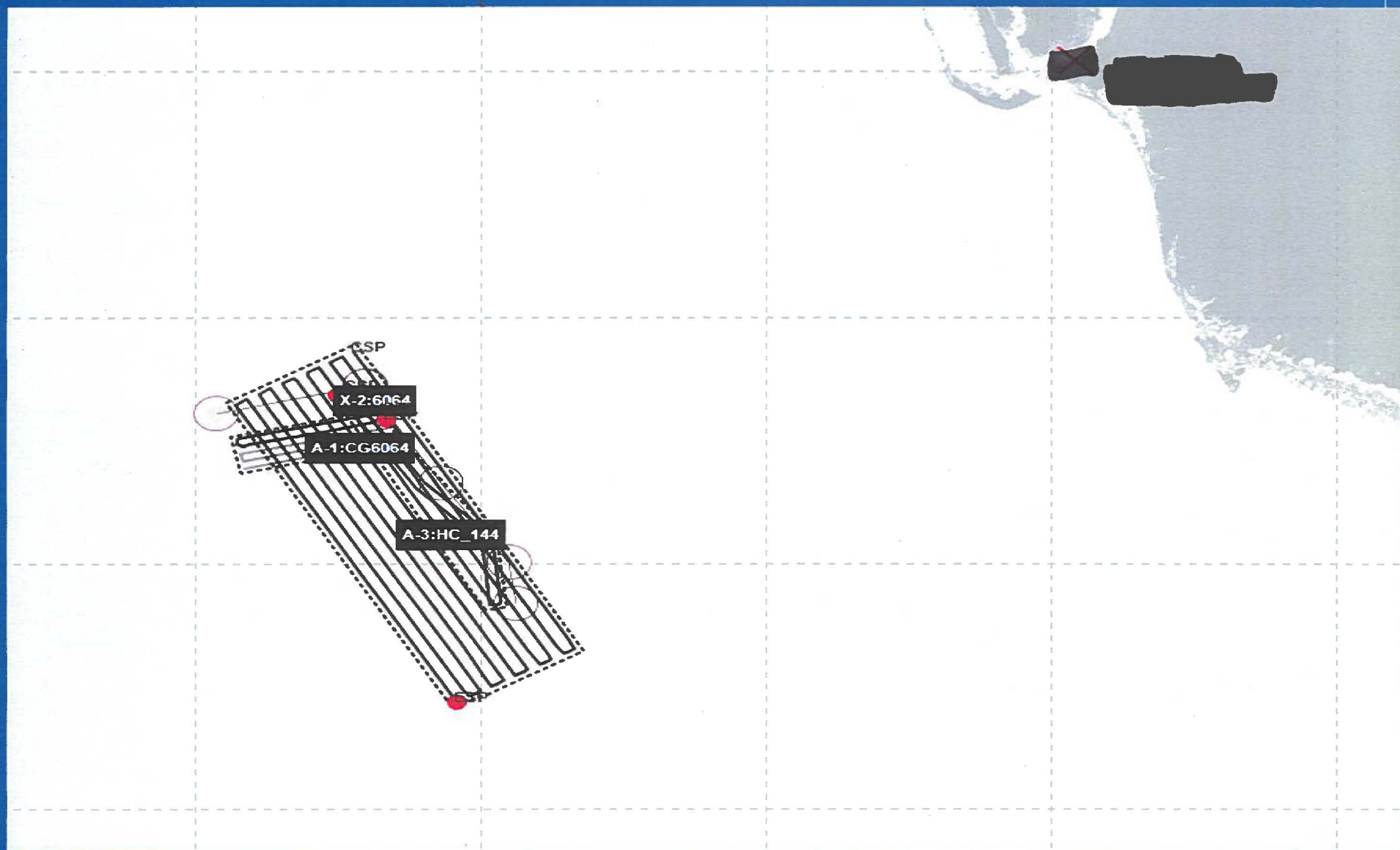

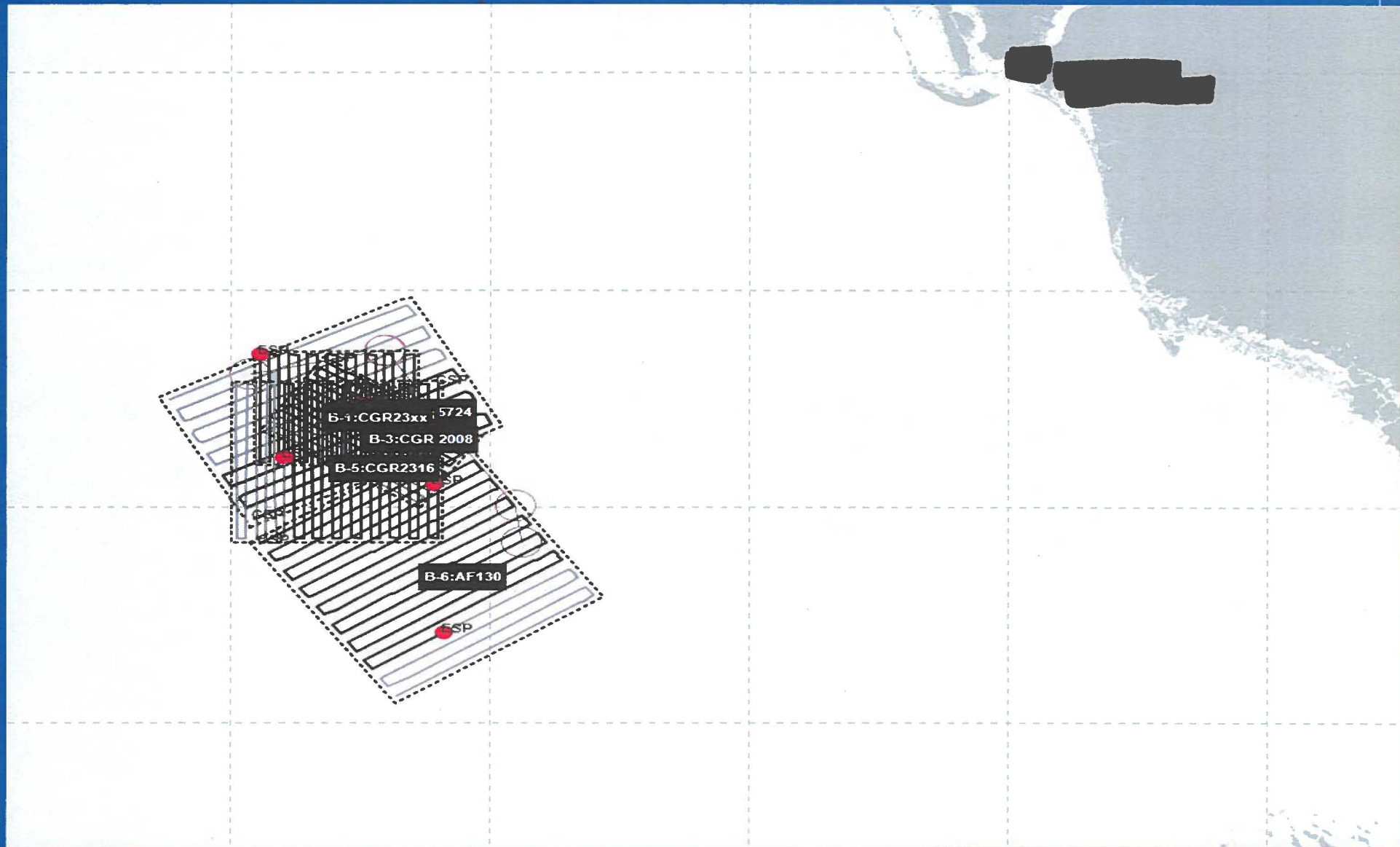

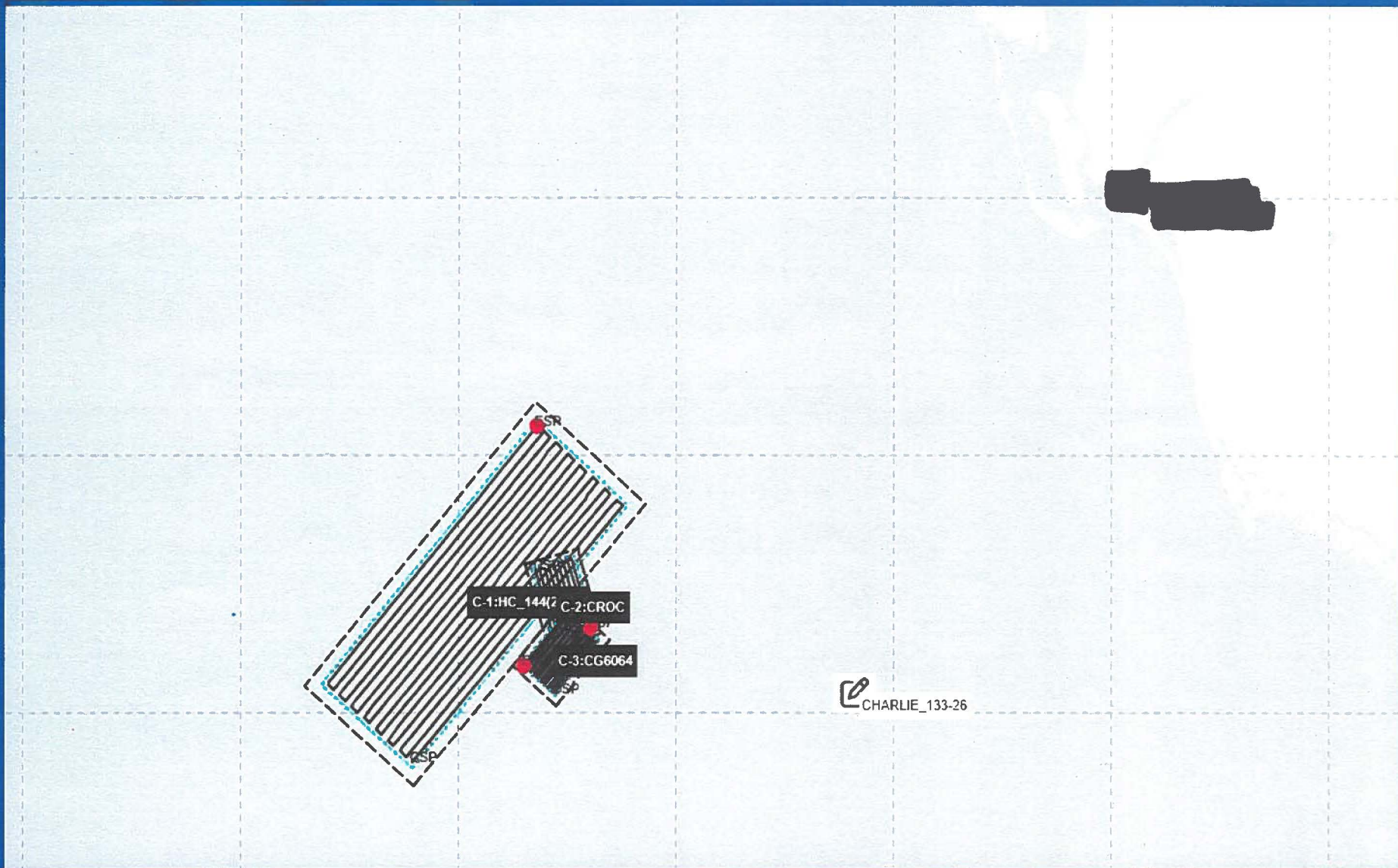

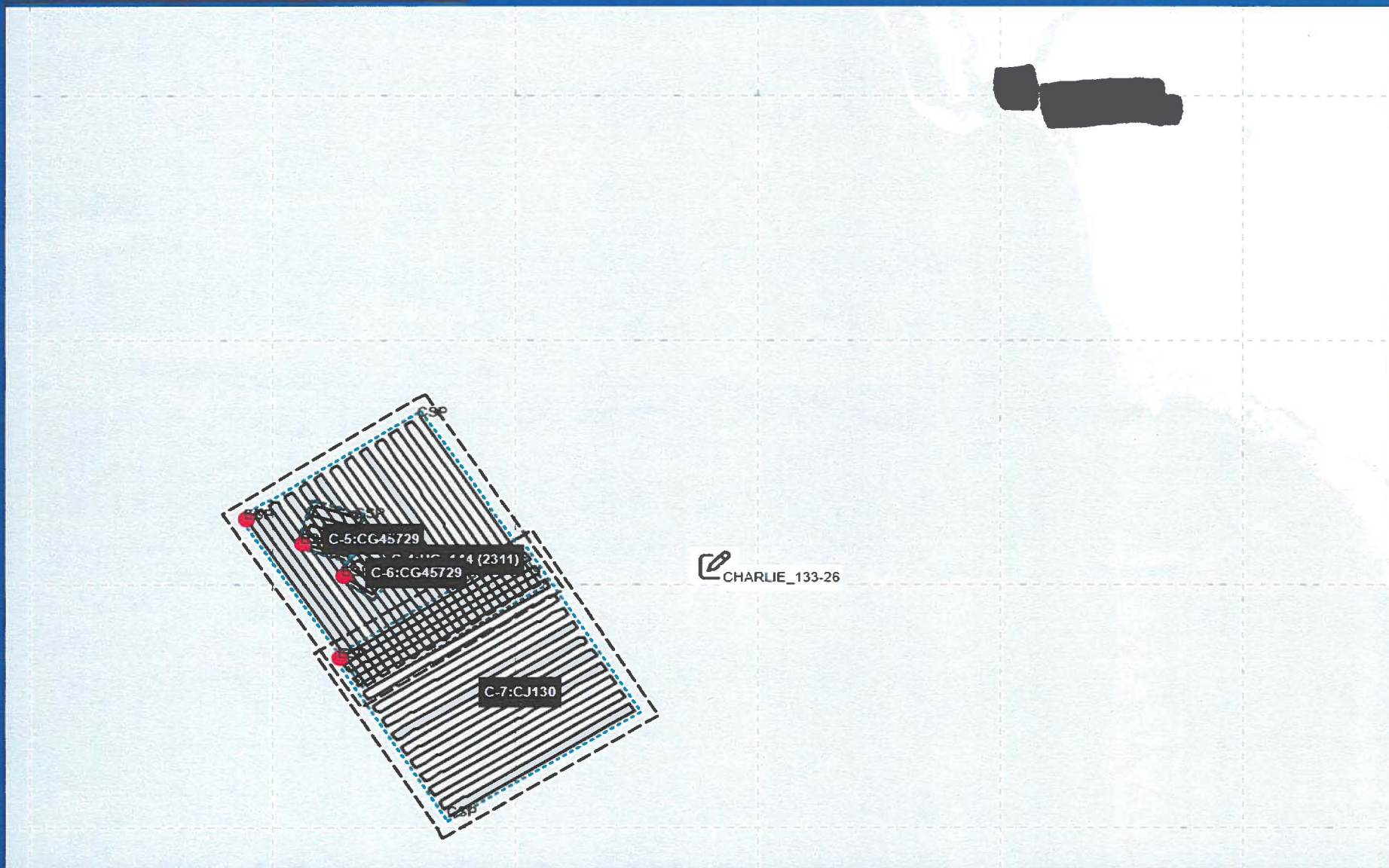

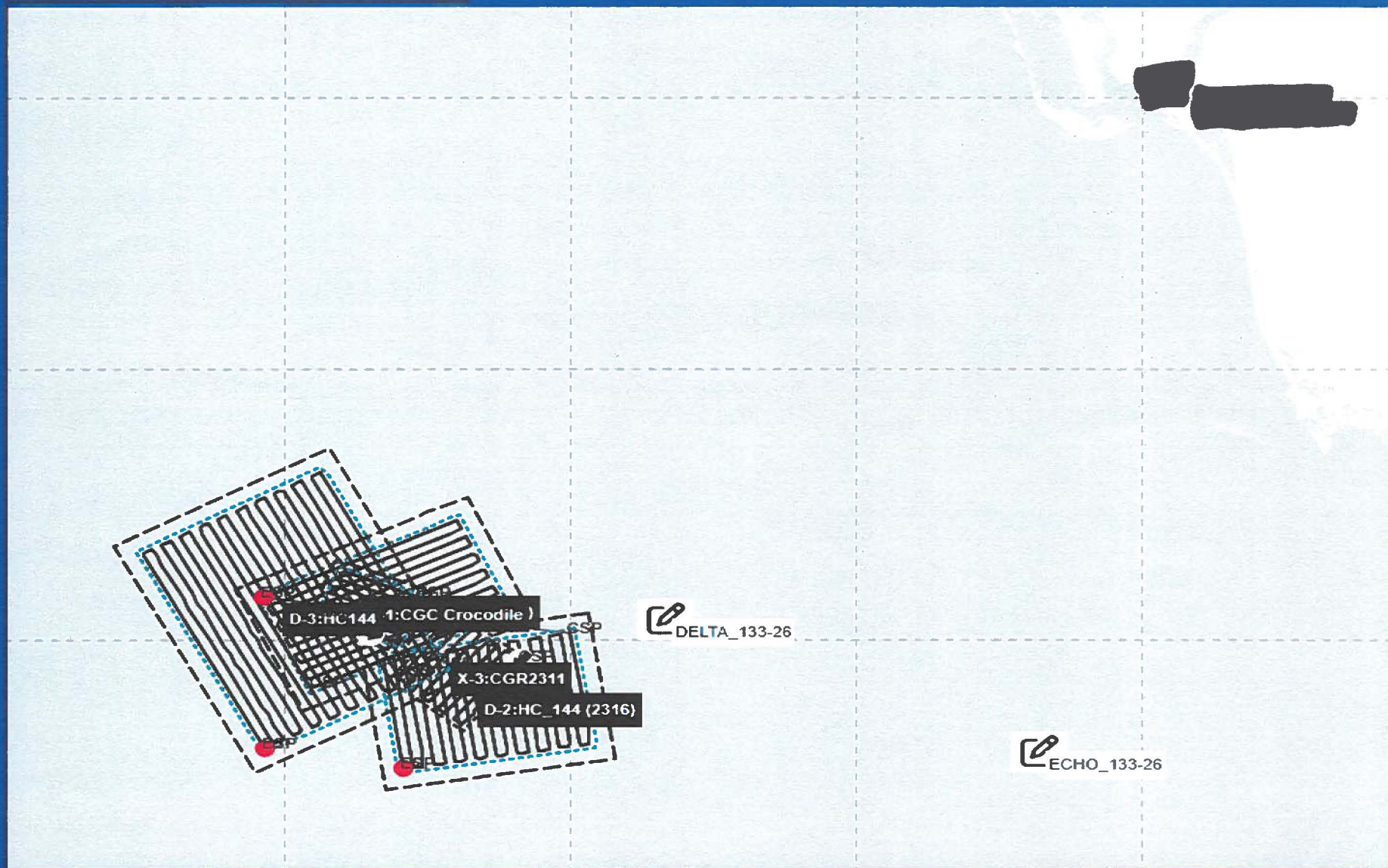

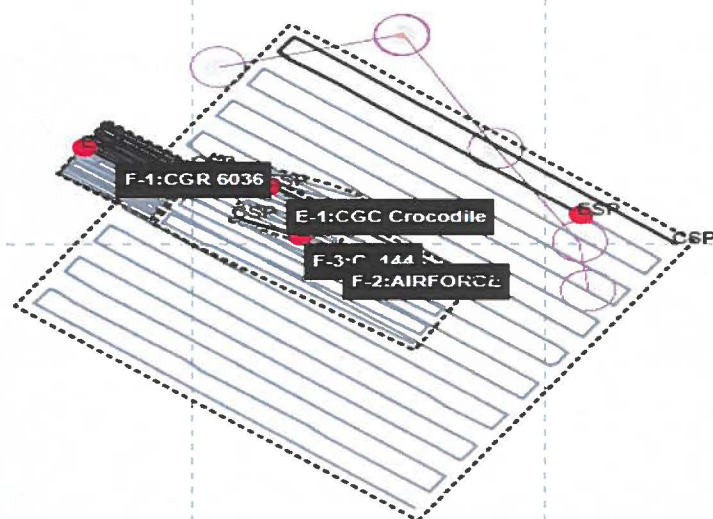

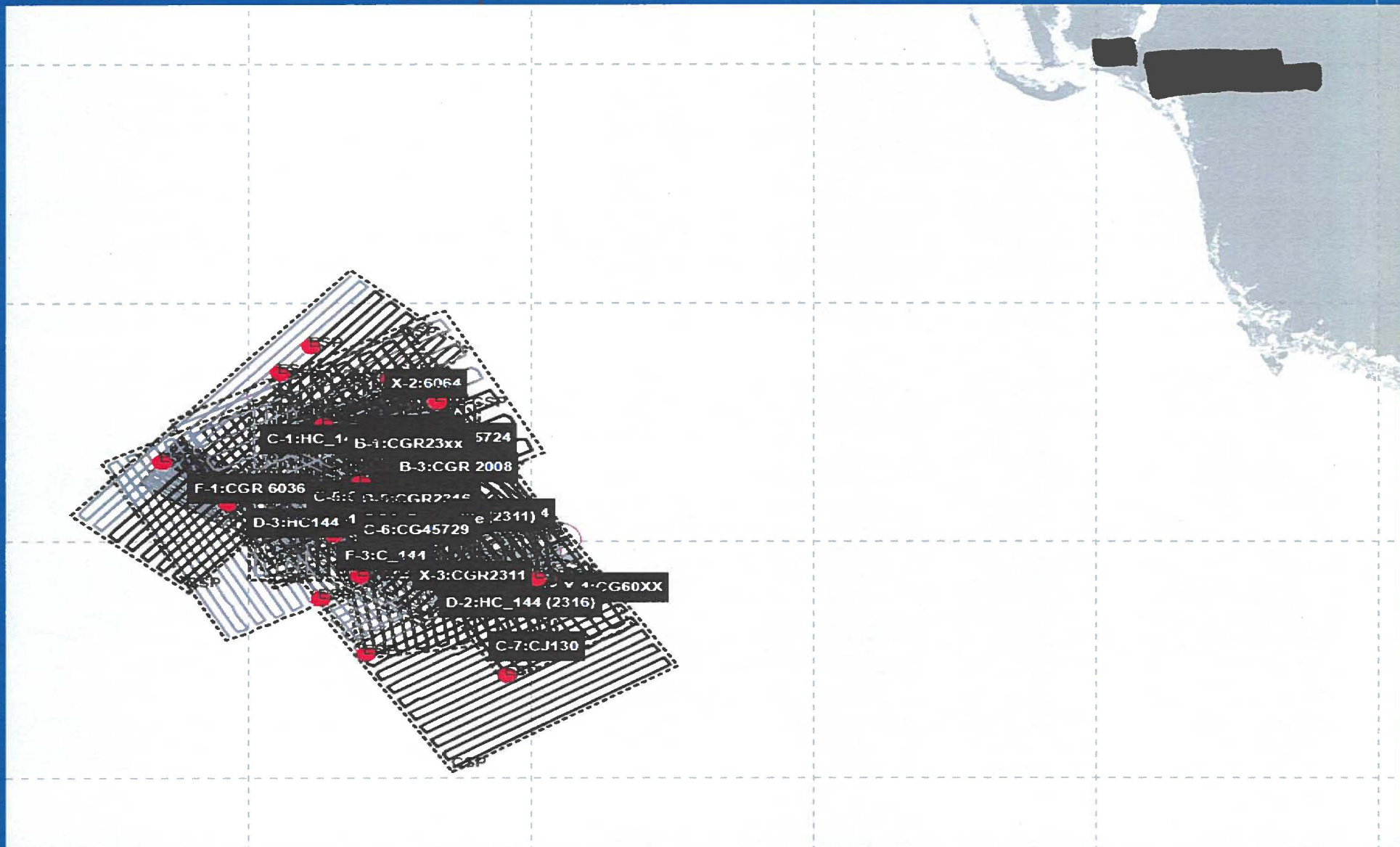
