THE BELOW NAMED COMPLAINANT BEING DULY SWORN, ON INFORMATION AND BELIEF STATES THAT:

Count 1: FIRST DEGREE RECKLESS HOMICIDE, USE OF A DANGEROUS WEAPON

The above-named defendant on or about Friday, September 4, 2026, at 1213 West Keefe Avenue, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, did recklessly cause the death of Marris Virgil, another human being, under circumstances which showed utter disregard for human life, contrary to sec. 940.02(1), 939.50(3)(b), 939.63(1)(b) Wis. Stats.

Upon conviction for this offense, a Class B Felony, the defendant may be sentenced to a term of imprisonment not to exceed sixty (60) years.

And further, invoking the provisions of sec. 939.63(1)(b) Wis. Stats., because the defendant committed this offense while using a dangerous weapon, the maximum term of imprisonment for the felony may be increased by not more than 5 years.

Probable Cause:

Complainant is a City of Milwaukee law enforcement officer and bases this complaint upon the reports of fellow law enforcement officers. Complainant has relied on similar reports in the past and has found them to be true and accurate. Complainant knows that said reports were written in the normal course of police business. Said reports indicate the following:

Officer Shelisa Carson stated that on September 4, 2026, she was dispatched to a shooting at 1213 W. Keefe Ave., City and County of Milwaukee. Carson stated that when she arrived on scene she located two young boys and a teenage girl screaming on the front porch. Carson stated that she entered the residence and located victim Marris Virgil on the floor of a second-floor bedroom, suffering from multiple gunshot wounds to the chest and face. Carson stated that paramedics arrived on scene to attempt life saving treatment, but were not successful - Mr. Virgil died on scene.

Dr. Brian Linert of the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office stated that he subsequently conducted an autopsy of Mr. Virgil. Dr. Linert stated that he observed that Mr. Virgil had sustained four gunshot wounds: one to the left arm, one to the left chest, and two to the left back. Dr. Linert determined that these gunshot wounds caused the death of Mr. Virgil.

Detective Robert Parks stated that he responded to 1213 W. Keefe Ave. to conduct the scene investigation. Parks stated that he observed Mr. Virgil's body to be located in a bedroom on the second

floor of the residence. Parks stated that next to Mr. Virgil's body were two spent 9mm casings. Parks stated that he observed a third spent 9mm casing on the stairwell down to the first floor.

Detective Levour Dawson stated that he also responded to the scene to conduct witness interviews. Dawson stated that he interviewed CZ, who stated that she was present at the time of the shooting. CZ stated that she is the long-term romantic partner of Mr. Virgil. CZ stated that shortly before the shooting, she and Mr. Virgil arrived to the residence after they received information that their 10 and 11 year old sons were playing Playstation video games with their cousin, Darrius Shelton (7/30/05), who is the above-named defendant. CZ stated that there was a dispute over who owned the Playstation: Mr. Virgil or the defendant. CZ stated that in the lead up to the shooting, Mr. Virgil and the defendant began to argue about the Playstation and who was entitled to it. An additional witness provided context that the Playstation had been purchased by Mr. Virgil/CZ, but at some point it stopped functioning properly, and the defendant paid to get it fixed. CZ stated that she offered to give the defendant \$260 for the Playstation but that the defendant declined.

CZ stated that the argument escalated, and she observed the defendant and Mr. Virgil to be chest to chest, in an aggressive posture. CZ stated that she momentarily turned away from argument between the defendant and Mr. Virgil, but she heard multiple gunshots come from that direction. CZ stated that right after she heard the gunshots, she turned to see the defendant holding a firearm. CZ stated that the defendant then pointed the firearm at her and threatened to shoot. CZ stated that the defendant then fled the scene.
