Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, on 1/5/2022, one staff member was the sole caretaker of six children, ages 8 months to 11 months, in the Crawler 2 Room. This exceeds the minimum staff to child ratio by one child. One staff member was the sole caretaker of ten children, ages 1 year to 2-years-old, in the Transition 1 Room. This exceeds the minimum staff to child ratio by four children. Two staff members were the caretakers of sixteen one-year-old children in the Toddler 4 Room. This exceeds the minimum staff to child ratio and maximum group size by four children.

225 - Licensee Responsibility Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:090. Section 8. General.

- (1) A licensee shall:
- (a) Be responsible for the operation of the child-care center pursuant to this administrative regulation, 922 KAR 2:120, and 922 KAR 2:280; and
- (b) Protect and assure the health, safety, and comfort of each child.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, on 1/5/2022, music was played at an excessively loud level in the Infant 2 and Crawler 2 Rooms. Staff members and surveyors were unable to hear each other in close proximity, due to the noise level of the music. This created a potential for staff members to be unable to hear a child who was crying or in distress while the music was playing.

On 12/16/2021, a 13-month-old child suffered a medical emergency of an unknown source while attending the child care center. The child stopped breathing and required CPR from staff members and Emergency Medical Services. The medical emergency resulted in the child receiving life support treatments in a hospital. As of 1/6/2022, the child continues to receive life support services.
