Executive Order No. 2025-05

Effective July 11, 2025, through August 31, 2025, I, Mayor Keith R. Sydnor, pursuant to the authority granted to the Office of the Mayor under the City Charter and in accordance with Article V – Curfew and Parental Responsibility, hereby issue Executive Order 2025-05, establishing a temporary city-wide juvenile curfew.

Curfew Restriction

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of seventeen (17) to be or remain in or upon any public place within the City of Laurel between the hours of:

11:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M., Sunday through Saturday.

Exceptions

This order shall not apply under the following circumstances:

- 1. When the juvenile or minor is accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.
 - When the juvenile or minor is returning home, by a direct route (without unnecessary detour or stop), within one (1) hour of the conclusion of any: School activity,
 - Activity of a religious or voluntary association, or
 - Event at a place of public entertainment (e.g., movie, play, or sporting event).
- When the juvenile or minor is legally employed and can present valid proof of employment upon request.

Enforcement

The Laurel Police Department is directed to enforce this curfew in accordance with applicable City laws and procedures. Officers may issue a youth field contact report (J-2) and notify parents or guardians, consistent with enforcement protocol outlined in City Code §9-63.
