Re: Beer throwing incident during Patriots vs Chiefs game

On October 14, 2018 there was an incident during the New England Patriots vs the Kansas City Chiefs game at Gillette Stadium in which a patron threw a beer at a Kansas City Chief Player in the south end zone. A subsequent investigation using surveillance video by the Team Ops Security Team and Foxborough Police Department Detective Patrick Morrison identified the male party that was observed on the video as the individual that threw the beer at the Chiefs player.

As a result of this investigation, a 21 year old male resident of Mansfield, Massachusetts has been identified and will be summoned into Wrentham District Court at a later date to face the following charges:

- -Disorderly Conduct
- -Throw object at sporting event

Chief William Baker will be holding a press conference at the Foxborough Public Safety Building, 8 Chestnut Street Foxborough, MA on October 15, 2018 at 4:45PM.

Pending charges represents accusations; all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt under the United States Constitution.
