## INFANT CRISIS SERVICES

They provide one week's worth of formula, food and diapers to babies and toddlers in crisis. ICS also connects families to community resources and other agencies to provide additional help. In addition to our Oklahoma City office, our innovative BabyMobile program--the ONLY program of its kind in our service area--takes formula, food, and diapers to infants and toddlers across 29 counties and 28,927 square miles of central Oklahoma; an impact that covers 42% of the state.

- Baby Wipes - Provide 4 packs of baby wipes for a new mom **\$10**
- Toddler Food - Provide food for 2 toddlers for 1 week **\$25**
- Baby Bundle - Provide one week's worth of diapers, wipes and formula for a new mom and her infant **\$50**

We accomplish this in three primary ways: comprehensive Clinic and Low Vision Services, meaningful Employment Opportunities, engaging Community Programs. NewView Oklahoma is the state's largest employer of blind and low-vision individuals, and the only comprehensive blind a low-vision clinic and rehabilitative service provider for patients of all ages in the state of Oklahoma.

- Transportation- One week's transportation to/from work **\$10**

## PIVOT

Founded in 1972, Pivot's mission was to provide crisis intervention and counseling for youth. Now Pivot's 12 acre campus is home to: a DHS-licensed shelter youth, an emergency shelter for young adults, a full-scale Counseling Center, a case management program, a juvenile justice support facility, 3 pantries to meet basic needs, a social enterprise jam company and 41 Tiny Homes for Transitional Living. Regardless of the point of entry to Pivot's campus, young people have access to all the wraparound services of the agency.

- Snack and Drink - Nourish a homeless youth with a healthy snack and drink **\$5**
- Underwear and Socks- Supply new underwear and warm socks for a deserving teen **\$10**

## REGIONAL FOOD BANK OF OKLAHOMA

The Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma is leading the fight against hunger in 53 counties in central and western Oklahoma. Founded in 1980, the Regional Food Bank is the state's largest domestic hunger-relief 501(c)(3) nonprofit that distributes food through a network of community-based partner agencies and schools. The majority of people served by the Regional Food Bank are chronically hungry children, seniors living on fixed incomes and hardworking families struggling to make ends meet.

## REMERGE

ReMerge works with women being released from prison and is a pathway to assimilating back into the community. A ReMerge mother is provided safe and stable housing, reunified with her minor children, maintains sobriety and working on stable employment. What makes ReMerge truly different from other diversion programs, is that upon graduation, a ReMerge mother is eligible to have her charges dismissed, removing a substantial barrier to the rest of her life.

- Safe Night - Provide security to an individual with one night of safe and sober housing. **\$25**
- Gift Card - Reward a deserving individual for reaching program milestones. **\$25**
- GED Materials - Promote education to an individual with the help of GED course materials. **\$30**
- Housing Deposit - Help provide stable housing with a Sober Living Housing Deposit. **\$50**
- Therapy Session - Supply one therapy session tailored to the individual's needs. **\$100**
