2022 Maple Avenue Narcotics Enforcement

In recent years, drug abuse and drug addiction have become a major burden to the citizens of Alamance County and the cities located therein. Law enforcement agencies are tasked with providing services to their respective communities in order to meet public expectations which include drug prevention, drug related crime prevention, drug abuse prevention and intervention. Alamance County law enforcement agencies devote considerable resources to strengthen the intensity and effectiveness of narcotics investigations.

Through these investigations, the Alamance County Sheriff's Office and the Burlington Police Department (ANET) identified the Maple Avenue corridor, which includes multiple hotel/motel locations, as a prime breeding ground for narcotics related activity. This includes the peripheral crime that is so often associated with narcotics related activity, in particular, prostitution and human trafficking.

As a result of this development, the Alamance County Sheriff's Office and the Alamance Narcotics Enforcement Team have developed an investigative initiative in an attempt to address these narcotics related issues in the Maple Avenue corridor. This initiative, dubbed "Taking Back the Streets, Together", began in August of 2022. Today, we will report on our most recent activities to date.
