Details of Offense

On 01/13/18, around 0200 hours, Uber driver Mitchell Patton, picked up Marlon Humphrey, Savanna McLaughlin, and two other unknown females, near the Strip area of the University of Alabama. Patton began driving to Hotel Capstone, when Humphrey asked to borrow a cell phone cable to charge his phone. Patton handed Humphrey his personal charging cable. When the vehicle arrived at Hotel Capstone, Humphrey refused to give the cable back to Patton, and grabbed several other cables from inside the vehicle. Humphrey and Patton exited the vehicle, and Patton attempted to recover his property. Humphrey refused to give Patton his property, and elbowed Patton in the side, not leaving a mark or doing any personal injury. Humphrey also balled up his fist, and acted like he wanted to fight Patton, if Patton continued trying to retrieve the property. When Humphrey exited the vehicle, he damaged additional property belonging to Patton.

UAPD Officers arrived at the scene, and found Humphrey inside the Hotel Capstone, holding Patton's cell phone cable. Humphrey and McLaughlin stated that the cable belonged to Humphrey, but Officers noticed, the cable did not fit Humphrey's phone.

Officers returned the cable to Patton, and he left the scene.
