Dear Mr. Reeder,

As we discussed, I am advancing this Freedom of Information request on behalf of the National Football League (NFL) Security Department, consistent with Kansas Open Records Act (KSA 45-215 et seq.). I am the NFL Security Representative in the Midwest Region affiliated with the Kansas City Chiefs.

This records request is in response to the recent Child Abuse complaints involving the parents Crystal Espinal and Tyreek Hill as it relates to alleged injuries sustained by the couple's minor child, [REDACTED]. As you know, Mr. Hill is a member of the Kansas City Chiefs Football Club (NFL).

The NFL Security Department respectfully requests the production of all reports relevant to this case including any and all calls for service calls to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] photographs; witness statements; police report narratives; medical records; video tapes; recordings of 911 calls and any reports related to review findings by the Johnson County, Kansas District Attorneys office. Please advise the process necessary to inspect or obtain copies of the requested records.

It is important to note that this request has no connection to any Law Enforcement Action or Legal Proceeding. The NFL request is a compulsory administrative review in accordance with the NFL Personal Conduct Policy. In short, the NFL is reviewing this incident to evaluate whether a violation of the NFL Personal Conduct Policy occurred related to a complaint or arrest involving an NFL employee, in this case, Mr. Hill.
