



**SAINT ANSELM COLLEGE SURVEY CENTER
APRIL 2019 POLL
SUPPORT FOR NEW HAMPSHIRE HIGHER EDUCATION**

These results are from a Saint Anselm College Survey Center poll based on interviews with 698 randomly-selected registered voters in the state of New Hampshire. Interviews were conducted by landline and cellular phone between April 3rd and April 8th, 2019. The overall survey has a margin of sampling error of 3.7% with a confidence interval of 95%. Data are weighted based on a voter demographic model derived from historical voting patterns, but are not weighted by party registration or party identification.
