“Defense team for former Stockton Police Sgt. Nicholas Bloed demands the immediate release of all grand jury transcripts.”

STOCKTON – Today the defense team for Nicholas Bloed is requesting the immediate release of all grand jury transcripts that the San Joaquin County District Attorney’s Office relied upon to bring charges in this case.

Specifically, the prejudicial actions taken through the grand jury process invite an unjust outcome. Attorney Allen Sawyer, lead counsel for Mr. Bloed stated, “[t]his is a one-sided star chamber where witness testimony is not subject to cross examination.” Further criticizing the grand jury process, Mr. Sawyer highlighted that “the right to confront your accusers is a bedrock constitutional principle establishing Due Process.” “Mr. Bloed has not been afforded the opportunity to face his accusers and until that happens, he has been denied his Due Process.”

Mr. Sawyer added, “[b]ased on our review of electronic communications between the Jane Does in this matter and other evidence reviewed, all sexual interactions were both consensual and often initiated by the Jane Does themselves.”
