
Stothert in Serious Trouble, 64% Say "Time for Someone New"


RE: Survey of n400 Likely Voters in Omaha Mayoral Election

New Poll: 64% of likely voters say it's "time for someone new" as Omaha Mayor. Just 29% believe Jean Stothert should be re-elected.



65% of Independent voters, 79% of Democrats, and even 48% of Republicans say
it's "time for someone new." 43% of voters say it's "definitely time for someone
new" underscoring the intensity of the opposition to a fourth term for Stothert.

Mike McDonnell has broad appeal and already leads Stothert on the ballot.



Mike McDonnell leads Jean Stothert 37% - 34% on the head-to-head ballot.
 McDonnell has broad appeal across party lines; as more voters get to know him, his ballot share will increase. With 64% of voters looking for someone new, Stothert is a well-known but unpopular figure, with a hard and low ceiling of possible support.

Methodology: This probabilistic tracking survey was conducted January 22 - 23, with 400 likely general election voters. It has a margin of error of $\pm 4.89\%$. Likely general election voters were interviewed via text-to-web and live calls. This survey was weighted to a 2025 likely general election universe.
