ORDER OF THE COURT

Comes now the Court and having viewed the WLKY interview Thursday evening after the Defendant's sentencing, does now set this cause of action for a Rule to Show Cause as to why the Defendant, Misty Noel, should not be held in Contempt of Court for providing false testimony at her change of plea hearing and further to set this matter for hearing to set aside the guilty plea and sentencing order as a result of Misty Noel telling the world that she did not "knowingly and intentionally" commit the crime of theft. "Knowing and intentionally" is the mens rea and a key element of the crime of theft. This Court cannot find an individual guilty if they profess and maintain their innocence. A jury will have to make that finding and therefore the Court will hold a hearing to set aside the guilty plea and set this matter for trial at the parties and the Court's earliest convenience.
