WELCOME!

Spring Valley County Park, consisting of 868 acres, is located in Shrewsbury, Springfield and North Hopewell Townships. The park is made up of old agricultural fields (showing hand built stone walls in some areas) and an uneven aged forest, with the East Branch of the Codorus Creek flowing through it. The park was named after "Valley of Springs" referenced in several poems written by nationally recognized poet laureate of Pennsylvania, Lee Anderson, who lived within the area that became the park.

Multi-Use Trails



Over twelve miles of trails are open to hikers, horseback riders, and mountain bikers. Trails are closed to bikers and horseback riders during muddy conditions. For updated trail conditions, call the parks office at 717-840-7440, follow us on Twitter (@yorkcountyparks)

Horseback riders and bikers must stay on designated trails!

Measured Trail Loops

- Cross Roads Parking Lot: Trail #5 to #6 to #5A to 5 to parking lot = $1 \cdot 3/4$ mile
- Folklife Parking Lot: Trail #4B to #4 to #3B to #2 to #2A to #2 to #1 to #1A to M3 to M1 to #6 to #5A to #5B to parking lot = $5 \frac{1}{2}$ miles

DIRECTIONS

Interstate 83, exit #8, Glen Rock. Rt. 216 east. Turn right on Potosi Road, travel 2 miles to Crest Road, where the park begins. Animal Activity Area is on Crest Road, while fishing areas and Fish For Fun Pond is located on Lehr Road.

PARK AMENITIES

- Animal Activity Area Two horse show rings and one practice ring can be rented for a fee or each can be rented separately. All three rings are locked except on the date of rental. Although numerous equestrian shows are held during the spring and summer months, other special interest groups can reserve this large open area.
- Pavilion The Porcupine Pavilion is conveniently located in the Animal Activity Area. It can be reserved for a fee by contacting the Adm. Harts. Fees are non-refundable.
- Fishing Pennsylvania Fish & Boat Commission Regulations apply.
- Fish for Fun Area This 1 acre pond contains catfish, pan fish and a number of small bass. Shore fishing only.
- East Branch Codorus Creek A trout stream stocked by the PA Fish & Boat Commission.
- Hunting Hunting is allowed in certain areas of the park, by Special Parks Permit only.
- Picnicking Picnic tables are scattered throughout the park.
- **<u>Dog Training Area</u>** An area of the park is open to train sporting dogs off leash from August 1st through March 31st. Dogs cannot be trained off-leash at any other time. Everything within park boundaries south of Potosi Road and Sunlight Drive is open to off-leash training. The Fish for Fun Pond is open for sports dog training during this same time. A Special Use and Activity Permit is required before a dog is allowed to run off leash.
- GeoCaching Placement allowed by Special Use *Permit* only.
