Affiant, being first duly sworn on oath, says that he has reason to believe as follows:

1. The following crime or crimes are being or have been committed:

Murder 21-5402 (a)(2)
Aggravated Endangering a Child 21-5601
Criminal Desecration (dead body) 21-6205

2. The person or persons alleged to have committed said crime:

Howard Jansen III (W/M [REDACTED])

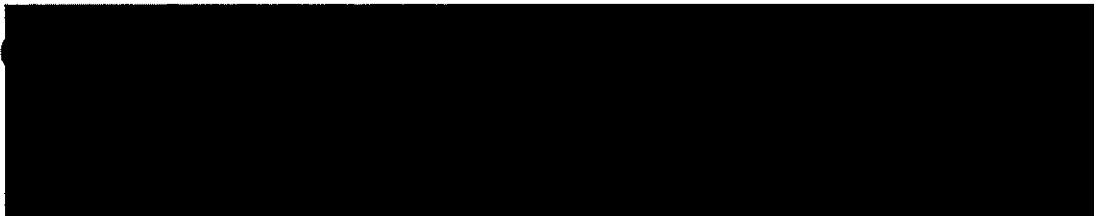
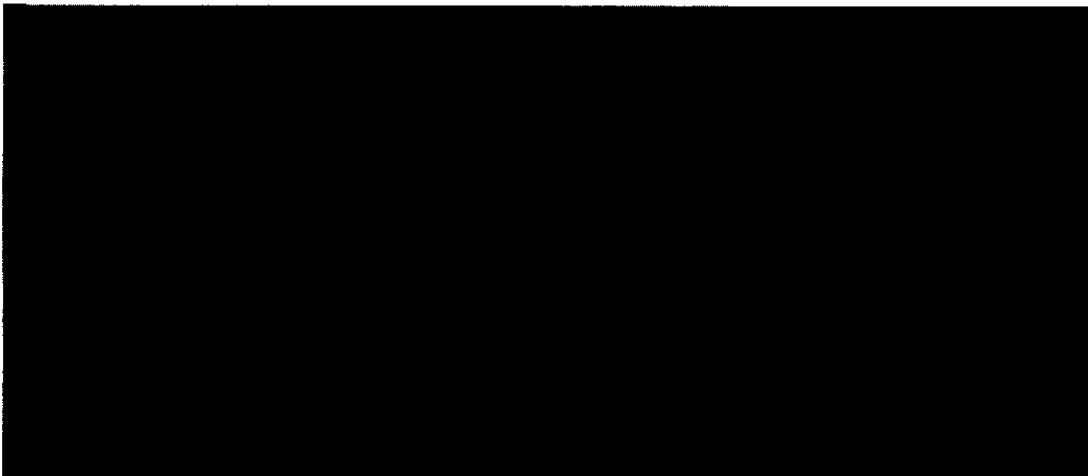
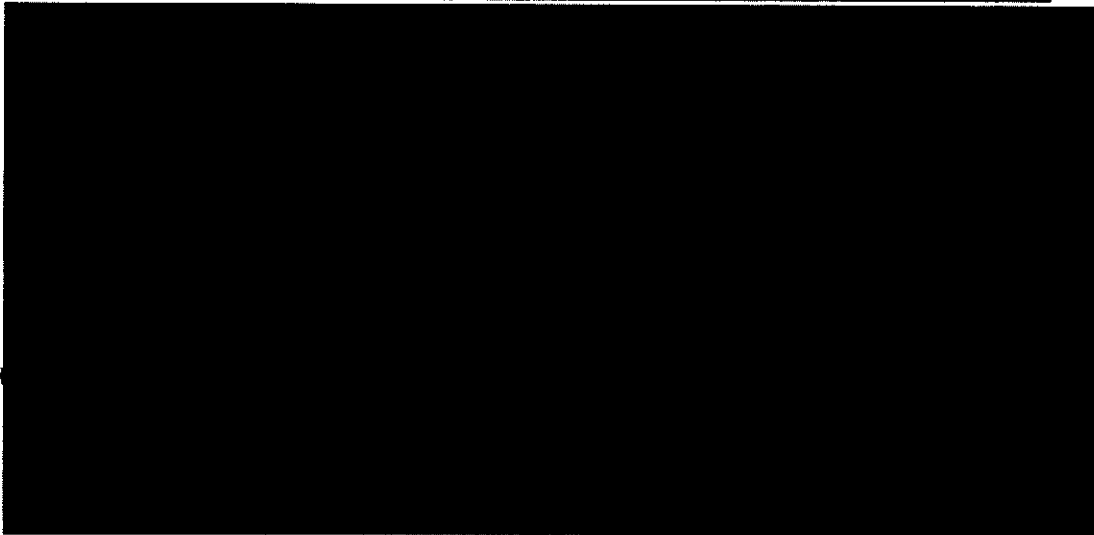
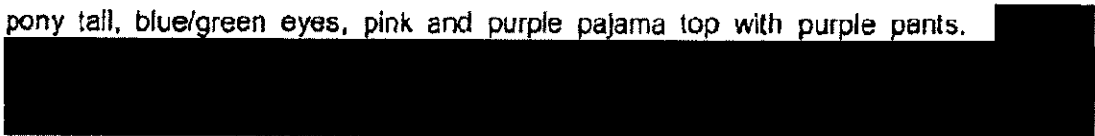
3. This affidavit and application is based on the following facts:

On 07-10-2020, at 0830hrs, Howard Jansen III (W/M [REDACTED]) and his girlfriend, Jacquelyn Kirkpatrick (W/F [REDACTED]) contacted Officer Dundovich at the Midtown Patrol Division where they responded to report Jansen's daughter as missing. Jansen identified his missing daughter as Olivia Ann Jensen (W/F [REDACTED]). Jansen advised that he came home to his residence at [REDACTED] on 07-09-2020 at approximately 1800hrs, and observed Olivia sleeping on the couch. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Officer Dundovich notified South Patrol Division supervisors who then sent officers out to begin searching the area of [REDACTED]. Detectives responded to [REDACTED] as well as the residence at [REDACTED]. Officer Dundovich directed Jansen and Kirkpatrick to meet officers at [REDACTED] to complete the report process.

When detectives arrived at [REDACTED] there were family members on scene. Detective Lee spoke to Jansen to obtain information about Olivia to issue an Amber alert. Jansen described Olivia as approximately 3ft tall, 50 to 60 lbs., brown hair with a

pony tail, blue/green eyes, pink and purple pajama top with purple pants.

Sgt. Paulokovich was in the area and notified of this information so he called for an additional officer to come search the area and Officer Miskec responded. Sgt. Paulokovich and Officer Miskec observed a trail that led into the wooded area where the person had reportedly exited from the woods morning. They followed the trail through the wooded area where Sgt. Paulokovich located an area of ground that had disturbed soil and branches, appearing to Sgt. Paulokovich to be a fresh grave site. They then secured the area as a crime scene. I responded to the 3600 block of Steele Rd and was directed in to the grave site.

I responded to the scene and entered the woodline on the north side of the street and walked north along the trail for approximately 200 feet to which point the path splits in two directions. Approximately 100 feet west of the split was the location that the body was located. I observed broken sticks and branches on top of the shallow grave. I could see light blue and pink clothing protruding from the dirt as well as a small portion of a Caucasian child's face and hair. The FBI Evidence Response Team and KCKPD CSI processed the scene and recovered the victim's body. When the victim's body was recovered it was confirmed to be Olivia Jansen. The victim was dressed in pajamas and her body had been placed in a fetal position. The victim had severe bruising all over her face.

The obvious visible injuries that are observed on the victim's body, and most notably the face, would have been apparent to anyone having contact with Olivia that she had suffered great physical abuse.

On 07-12-2020, Detective Bundy and CSI Burks attended the autopsy of Olivia Jansen which was performed by Dr. Hossain. The victim's body was 43" in length and weighed 33lbs. The victim's legs and arms were covered in bruising [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] There was a small cut on the back of her head. There was significant bleeding found under the skin on the outside of the victim's skull. When the skull cap was removed there was significant bleeding found on the back of the brain. The brain bleed was determined to be the cause of death.


