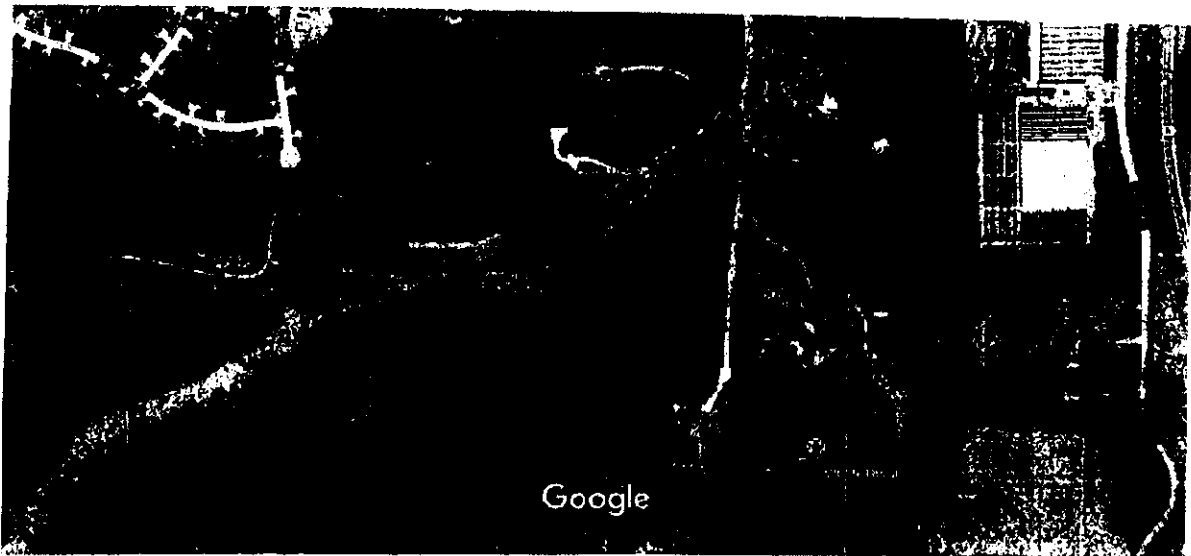

THAT, first responding officers were conducting their investigation and taking information for their report. They broadcast a description of the car in which Michael drove away from the house. A short time later, other officers found Michael Jones in that same vehicle in the area of 99th & Hutton Road, Kansas City, KS.

THAT, officers have interviewed Heather at length. She stated that Adrian had come to live with her and Michael when he was 3 years old. Before then Adrian had lived with his biological mother. The biological mother, according to Heather, has 9 children and none are in her custody. Heather told a story about Adrian being physically abused for days by a man who knew the biological mother. After Adrian came to live with Heather and Michael, he was diagnosed with post traumatic stress disorder with severe emotional detachment. She described him as being a psychopath, like a serial killer. According to Heather, Adrian has been a patient or client of a number of service providers in the Kansas City metro area such as Critendon Center; Hillsdale in Grandview, MO; and Kaw Valley Center. Some of the treatments lasted 6 months. Adrian was violent to the young girls living in the house. Heather and Michael had several daughters. Adrian attempted to insert a toy Superman figure inside one of the young girls—~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ Once, while Heather was pregnant, Adrian attempted to stab her in her abdomen.

THAT, on September 28, 2015, Michael approached Heather in their house on 99th Street, and told her that "we have a problem." Heather asked, and Michael said only that he would take care of it. Later, Michael told Heather that Adrian was in a mental hospital. She has not seen Adrian since Michael told her that there was a problem.

THAT, Michael, starting on September 28th, remained in the master bedroom for several days, and he would not allow her or any of their children to enter the bedroom. Then, Michael

pressured Heather to locate and purchase some pigs. Heather did locate, on Craig's List, some pigs for sale northwest of St. Joseph, Missouri. Michael went to purchase the pigs and he returned them to the residence on north 99th Street.

THAT, officers interviewed Michael Jones. Jones admitted that earlier this date he had struggled with his wife, Heather, and he had shot a .40 caliber Glock auto loading pistol into the air. They asked him to inventory his children. He listed the daughters' names. Police asked about a son. Michael told about a son named ██████████, who is ██████ years old and lives in ██████████. Police asked about another son. Michael teared up and said, "he's gone." Michael went on to explain that the son had been discovered dead in a shower stall in the North 99th Street house. He said that the son's body was kept in the house for several days, and that he had purchased pigs and fed the child's body to those pigs.

THAT, Michael stated that the pigs had eaten most of the boy's body. Michael had collected the remains, which included the skull, from the pig pen and put them into a metal can. Michael stated that on, November 25, 2015, he had moved the remains from the metal can to tub with a pink colored lid and then he put that pink tub near a chicken coop in the barn behind the house. Michael then circled an area on a map indicating the area of the barn.

THAT, officers interviewed ██████████. He is Michael's mother's brother. Uncle ██████ knew that Adrian was extremely difficult to manage. He knew that Adrian had been diagnosed with schizophrenia, and with an eating disorder, where he was obsessed with eating food. ██████ came from Maryland to live with the Jones'. In about early September, ██████ went to Maryland and at the start of October, 2015, he returned but before he did, he called Michael and asked if he was going to hospitalize Adrian, and Michael said it had been taken care of.

Michael has been living at 5201 N. 99th since his return and Michael told [REDACTED] that he had put Adrian into a mental health facility.

THAT, officers, when interviewing Heather, confronted her and asked for details of Adrian's death. Heather stated that prior to September 28, 2015, Michael had gotten angry with Adrian over Adrian stealing food. Michael beat Adrian by punching him with his fists, and then Michael confined Adrian to a shower stall in a bathroom. The confinement lasted for months. Michael refused to allow Heather to have access to Adrian most of the time. On the one occasion that Michael allowed her access to Adrian she observed him to have swollen extremities. Heather claimed to have military medical training, and she stated she believed the symptoms appeared consistent with internal bleeding. Michael did not allow Heather access to Adrian thereafter.

THAT, Heather went on to say that at some point it was evident that Adrian was dead. When she was allowed to see Adrian, she touched his body and found the body to be cold and stiff. It was still swollen. The skin color was yellowish. Michael asked her to cover Adrian's body, and she did. According to Heather, Michael took Adrian's body out to the pigs in the middle of the night.

THAT, Heather further stated that prior to Adrian's death, Michael had searched the internet for odorless, tasteless poisons. He did so by using his cell phone, a tablet, and a laptop computer. According to Heather, Michael hid information from her, and he controlled her by isolating her. She said he went so far as to manipulate her name off of her own bank accounts.

THAT, Heather stated that in order to bury Adrian's body, Michael went to Lowe's and purchased an auger. Michael then did not use the machine, and he returned it to Lowe's. The return receipt is on a table inside the house.

THAT, the Jones' had a surveillance system in the house with cameras and hard drive recording. The cameras recorded events that happened both inside and outside the house. Also inside the house is a Nokia cell phone used by Michael.

THAT, on the property at 5201 N. 99th Street, there is a barn, and there is a shed both of which are detached from the house.

THAT, after Adrian's body was fed to the pigs, Michael took tarps, tile, wood from the bathroom, and other articles permeated with odor and brown matter from Adrian's body to a place in the yard, behind the house and burned it. Officers saw burned residue on a pile in the back yard.


THAT, 5201 N. 99th Street is depicted in the attached overhead photograph.

WHEREFORE, having shown probable cause that the crimes of murder or manslaughter have been committed, I am requesting a search warrant issue ordering KCKPD officers to search the residence at 5201 N. 99th Street, Kansas City, Wyandotte County, Kansas, as well as curtilage and all barns, sheds, and any other outbuilding, for evidence including the following:

- The body of or remains of the body of Adrian Jones, a male of approximately 7 years of age; said remains to include bones, skull, and human body tissues.
- Any blood, human biological material, hair, and/or deoxyribonucleic acid from Adrian Jones.
- A return receipt from Lowe's, on a device capable of digging dirt.
- A tub with a pink colored lid.
- A metal feeding trough.
- An orange plastic feeding trough.
- Wooden boards with Adrian Jones' blood or body fluids on them.

- Nokia cell phone, and any other cell phone.
- Laptop computer.
- Tablet computer.
- .40 caliber spent shell casing.
- Burned and charred remnants from an ash pile in the yard.
- DVDs, CDs, hard drives, and other digital storage media devices; and home security system, including cameras, recording devices, alarms and monitors.
