- 5 days a week
- Daily contact by teachers
- Materials provided
- Special services provided
- Honors courses offered
- PTC/Lander virtual offerings
- Odysseyware, Calvert
   Learning, and VirtualSC
- Application must be completed
- Athletics and extracurricular activities
- Semester long commitment



# **TRADITIONAL**

5 DAYS A WEEK/FACE-TO-FACE
INSTRUCTION
GRADES: PK - 12TH

### **DESCRIPTION**

- Traditional face-to-face instruction for 5 days a week
- Each school will develop schedules and protocols for breakfast, lunch, recess, and related arts based on safety guidelines
- Face covering will be required at a minimum in common areas and where social distancing is limited (pending Board approval)
- School specific information will be mailed prior to the start of school

### THINGS TO KNOW

- Enhanced health and safety protocols in place
- Sharing of objects and materials will be limited
- PPE equipment will be provided to staff
- Face coverings will be provided to students as needed

### **CALENDAR**

- Students and staff follow the district calendar
- Arrival and dismissal times for first semester are subject to change pending final scheduling and transportation needs

# HYBRID INSTRUCTION GRADES: PK-12TH

### **DESCRIPTION**

- Face-to-face instruction with students divided into A day and B day groups
- Combination of alternating face-to-face days and completing additional assignments virtually
- Rolling alternating A/B days (ex. August 18-A day, August 19-B day, August 20-A Day, August 21-B Day, August 24-A Day, August 25-B Day, August 26-A Day, etc.)
- Face covering will be required at a minimum in common areas and where social distancing is limited (pending Board approval)
- School specific information will be mailed prior to the start of school

#### THINGS TO KNOW

- Enhanced health and safety protocols in place
- Sharing of objects and materials will be limited
- PPE equipment will be provided to staff
- Face coverings will be provided to students as needed
- Meals sent home on alternate days
- Special services provided (Gifted and Talented, Special Education, Speech, ESOL, interventions, etc)
- ACTS, STEMS, AVID, GSI, Montessori, and ECC students can choose this model

### **CALENDAR**

- Students and staff follow the A/B designations on the district calendar
- Arrival and dismissal times for first semester are subject to change pending final scheduling and transportation needs

# VIRTUAL

## GWD50 VIRTUAL LEARNING PROGRAM GRADES: K5-12TH

### **DESCRIPTION**

- Virtual learning 5 days a week
- Daily contact by teachers
- Chromebook and other materials provided
- Odysseyware, Calvert Learning, and VirtualSC
- School counselor will contact students regarding schedule for program
- Program specific information will be mailed prior to the start of school

### THINGS TO KNOW

- Athletics & Extra-curricular activities offered
- Special services provided (Gifted and Talented, Special Education, Speech, ESOL, interventions, etc)
- Honors courses offered
- Magnet student's spot will be held for 2020-2021 school year if student remains enrolled in D50
- ECC & 3 yr. & 4 yr. olds can not participate in the virtual learning program

- · Students follow traditional school calendar
- 5 days a week
- Attendance mandatory
