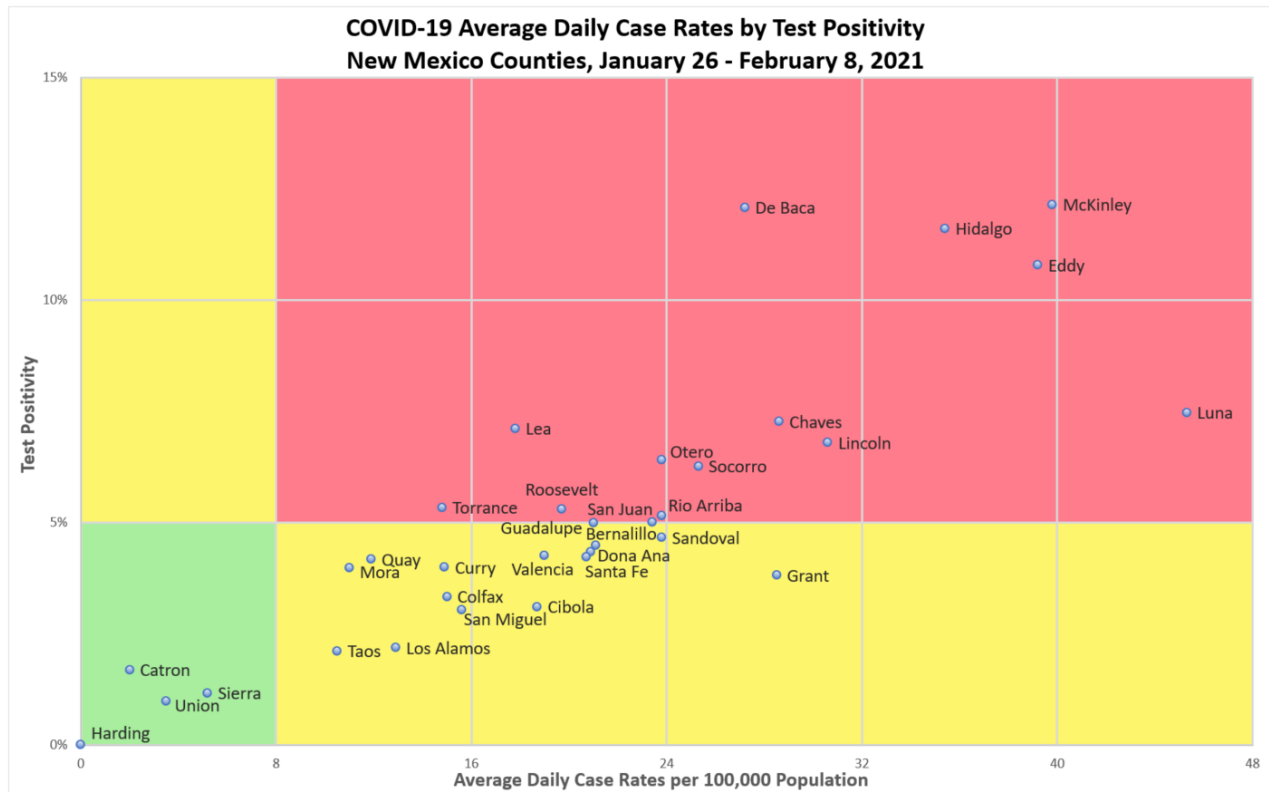


# New Mexico COVID-19 Testing Thresholds Report



February 9, 2021



**Red Level-Very High Risk:** Counties at the Red Level are those with both a new COVID-19 average daily case incidence rate of greater than 8 cases per 100,000 inhabitants during the most recent two-week period and an average percent of positive COVID-19 test results over the most recent 14-day period greater than 5%.

**Yellow Level-High Risk:** Counties at the Yellow Level are those with either a new COVID-19 average daily case incidence rate of no greater than 8 cases per 100,000 inhabitants during the most recent two-week period, or an average percent of positive COVID-19 test results over the most recent 14-day period less than or equal to 5%.

**Green Level-Medium Risk:** Counties at the Green Level have both a new COVID-19 average daily case incidence rate of no greater than 8 cases per 100,000 inhabitants during the most recent two-week period, and an average percent of positive COVID-19 test results over the most recent 14-day period less than or equal to 5%.

**Notes:**

Data for both cases and tests include 14 complete days of data during the period and exclude cases among inmates in state and federal corrections and detention centers.

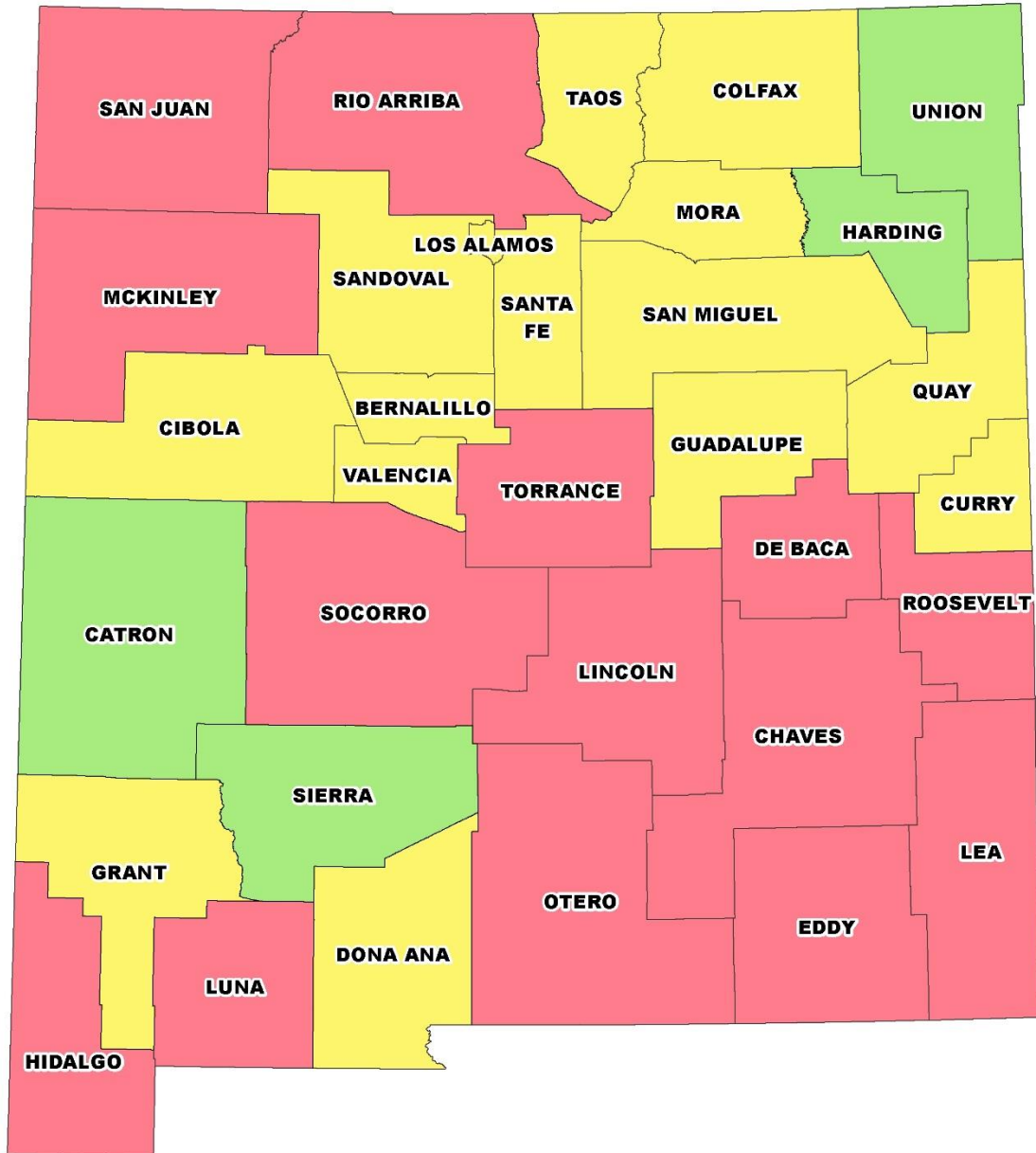
Tests: Lab record created in previous 14 days, specimen collection in the previous 14 days from lab record created

Cases: Case investigation created within the previous 14 days, specimen collection within 14 days of case creation

- Both Average Daily Cases more than 8 per 100,000 and Test Positivity greater than 5%
- Either Average Daily Cases 8 or fewer per 100,000 or Test Positivity 5% or lower
- Both Average Daily Cases 8 or fewer per 100,000 and Test Positivity 5% or lower
