Family of Deputy Brandon Shirley calls for a comprehensive investigation into his murder.

The family of Jefferson County Sheriff's Deputy Brandon Shirley, who was tragically killed in the line of duty, is heartbroken and deeply frustrated following the dismissal of charges against the two men accused of his murder.

They are now calling for a renewed and thorough investigation into his death, urging law enforcement and community leaders to employ all available resources to bring those responsible to justice. Deputy Shirley, who was ambushed and fatally shot while working an off-duty security detail in August 2021, was just 26 years old. His family continues to mourn their devastating loss while navigating the anguish of an unresolved case.

"This is not just about seeking justice for Brandon. It's about ensuring that no other family has to endure what we're going through," the Shirley family said, "Our son dedicated his life to serving and protecting others, and he deserves a real investigation by people who genuinely care about finding the truth."

The family is disappointed with the case handling so far and is calling on law enforcement agencies and the community to rally together, prioritize this case, and leave no stone unturned in pursuing justice for Brandon.

The Shirley family stated, "We need someone with the passion and determination to truly see this through. Brandon was a son, a brother, and a friend to so many. He mattered. And we will not stop until his killers are held accountable."

The family is urging anyone with information related to the case to come forward and assist investigators. They also welcome the support of organizations and individuals who share their commitment to justice and accountability.

Deputy Shirley's legacy as a decided public servant lives on, and his family remains resolute in their quest for justice.

The family has committed to add an extra \$10,000 of their own money to the existing \$75,000 reward for information that leads to the conviction of Brandon's murderer.
