SHOW CAUSE ORDER
(Incarceration Not Requested)

Pursuant to Maryland Rule 15-206, a Gag Order having been issued by the Court on June 7, 2022, in the above-referenced cases, Defendant Keith Davis, Jr. having filed a Petition for Contempt alleging that Baltimore City State's Attorney Marilyn Mosby has not complied with the Gag Order, and the Court finding that the Petition is not frivolous on its face, it is this 21st day of June, 2022, by the Circuit Court for Baltimore City, Part 35, hereby:

ORDERED that State's Attorney Marilyn Mosby shall appear before the Circuit Court for Baltimore City, 100 North Calvert Street, Room 434M, Baltimore, Maryland 21202 on **August 12, 2022, at 9:30 a.m.**, and show cause why she should not be held in constructive civil contempt, provided that the Petitioner serves copies of the Petition for Contempt and the Gag Order along with a copy of this Show Cause Order within thirty (30) days after the date of this Order by certified mail, restricted delivery and return receipt requested, by private process server, or by the Sheriff; and it is further

ORDERED that State's Attorney Marilyn Mosby shall file any written answer to the Petition with the Clerk of this Court no later than **August 5, 2022**, again provided the Petition for Contempt and the Gag Order are served with a copy of this Show Cause Order as required above within thirty (30) days after the date of this Order; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk shall assign this action for hearing on August 12, 2022.
