NARRATIVE:

On June 1, 2018, Palm Beach Sheriff's Office (PBSO) Deputies responded to 3700 S Ocean Blvd, unincorporated Boynton Beach, FL in reference to a deceased female infant being located in the water off shore. PBSO's Marine Unit recovered the infant and delivered her to shore. Detective C. Hamilton #5322 from PBSO's Special Victim's Unit (SVU) responded to the scene as well as the PBSO Crime Scene Unit (CSI). PBSO, along with the surrounding counties, made contact with all parents who gave birth to a baby girl in the month of May, as the child was estimated to be up to two weeks old. All efforts to identify the victim and her parents were exhausted.

The Palm Beach County Medical Examiner's Office conducted an autopsy. Under the "Autopsy Findings" section, their report stated the following:

"Well developed, non-white, non-Asian female infant with morphometric measurements consistent with a 38-40 week gestational age infant and:

- a. History of being found floating in the ocean
- b. Early decomposition changes and anthropophagy
- c. No evidence of lethal trauma or natural disease
- d. Two heel punctures on the right heel
- e. Liver tissue positive for caffeine and ethanol

Cause of death: Asphyxia

Manner of death: Homicide

How injury occurred: Physical and toxicological findings support that the infant was born alive and in a healthcare environment."

In June 2022, Det. B. Hansen #13045 was notified by the PBSO Crime Lab that they generated a lead as to the potential father of the deceased child as a [REDACTED] Det. Hansen was able to make contact with [REDACTED] over the phone. Det. Hansen provided him with some

information regarding the investigation and he agreed to provide a DNA sample. [REDACTED] also informed Det. Hansen that he [REDACTED] Arya Singh, who told him in 2018 that she was pregnant by him but never had the baby. He explained that [REDACTED] in 2017 and he did not know she was pregnant until she told him the following year after he moved to Tallahassee.

On 7/13/22, Your Affiant spoke with [REDACTED] over the phone and we agreed to meet in Tallahassee on 7/22/22. [REDACTED] voluntarily provided a DNA sample and a sworn audio/video recorded interview was conducted. [REDACTED] stated the following: he met Arya Singh in high school and they [REDACTED] several years later. They were together until September or October 2017. They did not speak to or see each other after [REDACTED]. In May 2018, [REDACTED] moved to Tallahassee, FL for work. In June 2018, he and Arya began to talk on the phone and sometime in August or September of 2018, he traveled to West Palm Beach to attend a concert with her. During a conversation between June and August, she told him that when [REDACTED] she was pregnant. She told him she "took care of it". He does not remember if she said she had an abortion or if he assumed she did. He tried asking her about the baby and asked for any medical paperwork she had so he could have his own closure. She refused to speak about it and eventually, he stopped asking. After he traveled to West Palm Beach in August or September, they [REDACTED] however, it ended months later. He has not seen or spoken to Arya since. Your Affiant showed [REDACTED] a photo of Arya Singh DOB 4/8/93 and he confirmed that she [REDACTED] who told him she was pregnant.

On 7/29/22, Your Affiant was informed that the PBSO Crime Lab had completed analysis on [REDACTED] DNA sample and he could not be excluded as the father. On 7/29/22, the PBSO Tactical (TAC) Unit began conducting surveillance on Arya Singh in order to gather information and obtain a surreptitious DNA sample from her. On 8/14/22, the PBSO TAC Unit obtained a discarded coffee cup used by Arya Singh, which was placed into evidence and analyzed by the PBSO Crime Lab. On 8/18/22, Your Affiant was notified by the PBSO Crime Lab that there were two contributors on the cup (one male and one female), with the female DNA contributor deduced to be Arya Singh. Her DNA sample was confirmed to be the alleged mother of the unknown child. On 8/23/22, a request was submitted to Bode Technology to provide calculations on the alleged paternity of the unknown infant using the DNA obtained from [REDACTED] and Arya Singh. On 8/29/22, Bode Technology completed their report which confirmed [REDACTED] and Arya Singh to be the parents of the unknown infant.

Google location data was obtained for Arya Singh's Google account and showed the following: On 5/30/18 at 9:35pm, the device's GPS coordinates show 26.5451876, -80-0438801. A search of these coordinates put them at the lifeguard stand on N Ocean Blvd, Ocean Ridge, FL 33435, which is where the Boynton Beach Inlet is located. At 9:38pm, while only changing by a few degrees, the coordinates are 26.5453726, -80-0432978, which puts the location at 6999 N Ocean Blvd, Ocean Ridge, FL 33435. The GPS Coordinates show her device at this location until 10:01pm. Her next location at 10:06pm shows that she may have been traveling southbound on N Ocean Blvd. A further search for these coordinates found that her device was at the Boynton Beach Inlet or close to that area throughout the day on 5/30/18.

In reference to Arya's Google web searches, the following searches were observed on 5/30/18 which are listed out by their times and the words used to search (verbatim):

- 8:41am - "cheap hotels near me" to include Boca Raton, Delray Beach and Boynton Beach. There

are a total of eight searches for hotels beginning at 8:41am until 10:45am.

- 9:45pm and 9:47pm - "what lives in the Boynton inlet"
- 9:50pm - "how to setup a google alert"
- 9:53pm - "Boynton inlet"
- 9:55pm - "how to create google notification on android"
- 9:58pm - "how to create google alert on android"
- 9:59pm and 10:00pm - "Boynton inlet cam"
- 10:01pm-10:55pm - 23 searches for "Boynton inlet"
- 10:56pm-11:18pm - 10 searches for "Boynton beach news"
- 11:18pm and 11:19pm - "florida news"
- 11:20pm and 11:21pm - "palm beach county news"

Beginning on 5/30/18 until 6/30/18, there are 574 searches for "Boynton inlet". From 5/30/18 at 11:20pm until 5/31/18 at 9:28 pm, there are 34 searches for "palm beach county news". Furthermore, on 5/30/22, she visited the following websites:

- 9:45pm - "Boynton Inlet (Boynton Beach Inlet: All you need to know before you..." which is a link to a tripadvisor.com page regarding the Boynton Beach Inlet
- 9:46pm - "Why is the Boynton Inlet so treacherous? - Youtube"

- 10:00pm - <https://www.swellinfo.com/surfreport/boyton-inlet-florida-cam>

On 5/31/18, Arya searched for "Boynton beach news today" 27 times and visited several news websites. On 6/1/18, she continued searching "Boynton inlet", "Boynton beach news today", and several different local news websites. At 5:13pm on 6/1/18, she visited <http://amp.wptv.com/2606273103/infants-body-found-near-boynton-inlet.html>, which appears to be the first article found regarding the investigation into her baby's body being located. From 6/1/18-6/30/19, she visited approximately 64 articles regarding her child on both local and national news websites, with most of the articles being accessed within the first two weeks. She also visited PBSO's and other news companies' Twitter updates regarding her unidentified baby. The later articles she visited included a sketch of the baby.

On 6/12/18 at 4:37pm, Arya visited <http://cbs12.com/news/local/questions-linger-after-body-of-baby-girl-found-near-boynton-beach>. In this article, the reporter spoke with Boca Raton Police Chief Scott regarding this investigation. The article states the following: "Another piece of evidence that might lead investigators to the baby's parents: her DNA. 'That DNA can or may be used against the CODIS system they have in the U.S. to run that DNA to see if there is a close match,' Scott said, possibly identifying a relative or maybe even her parents." Two minutes later, at 4:39pm, she conducted a Google web search for "Codis DNA". On 6/18/18, she searched for her own name, "arya singh", several times. She also searched "baby san juan", "baby san juan Trinidad", "san juan Trinidad", "san juan baby", and "san juan Trinidad baby". Singh's family and heritage is from Trinidad and Tobago.



Based on the above described investigation, Arya Singh has been found to be the mother of the unidentified newborn baby found deceased in the Boynton Beach Inlet. The medical evidence shows the deceased baby was born alive and died due to "asphyxia." GPS data shows Singh at the Boynton Beach Inlet just under 48 hours prior to the baby being recovered from the water. Furthermore, Singh's Google search history shows a significant amount of searches for the Boynton Beach Inlet during the time in which she was at that location and afterwards. At no time has Arya

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Singh reported her child missing to law enforcement. Based on this information, in addition to the father's statement regarding Arya Singh's pregnancy revelation, I find that Arya Singh did kill her newborn baby contrary to Florida Statute Section 782.04(1)(a)1. (CAPITAL FELONY)
