To ALL UAW/Ford Active Production and Skilled Trades Members:


As the contract deadline approaches, it is essential that we send a clear message to Ford Motor Company that we are prepared to take the necessary steps in order to achieve equity in our National and Local Agreements. You can assist your negotiators by taking part in the upcoming strike authorization vote. The purpose of this strike authorization vote is to give the negotiating team the authority to determine whether or not a strike is necessary in order to accomplish their goal in securing a contract that is fair and equitable for all parties concerned.


While it is crucial to include every members vote, Local 862 must adapt to the strike authorization vote request for Local 862. Therefore, this notification provides the most advanced notice possible with increased polling hours from the 2015 strike authorization vote. Unfortunately, every members' work schedule will not be represented, but due to notification timing and voting response time constraints, Local 862 will vote the following times:
