I recognize that very few of the questions were related to compensation, but I still saw the large number of responses that addressed salary and benefits. In addition, I also noted the extreme focus of the questions on management and leadership, and I am thankful for your honest responses.

The Detention Bureau is a large ship and it will not turn on a dime. I'm excited to be the Sheriff because I have the opportunity to turn this ship, to make the changes. I welcome your continued feedback, and I want you to know I'm excited about the future.

I took office in 2018 with an open-door policy and it has not changed. At the beginning of this year, I created physical office space for myself in the Detention Center. I am excited to continue interacting with Detention staff and learning firsthand what it is like to work in the Detention Center.

We know our Detention staff are an invaluable part of the FCSO Family and we want our community to realize that too.

Although this email mainly addresses the survey, the most important thing I want you to know is that I hear you and I am here for you.
