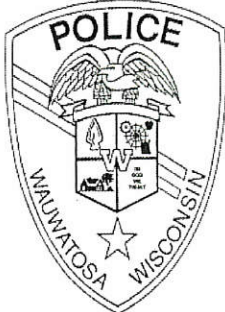

On 05-11-2018 I, PO Evan Olson, was assigned to patrol Mayfair Mall, 2500 N. Mayfair Rd. I was operating a fully marked Wauwatosa Police squad and in a full Wauwatosa Police uniform.

At approximately 4:37pm, PO Daniel Akins and I were dispatched to a disorderly conduct complaint located at entrance #10 to the mall near west Macy's. PO Akins was also assigned to patrol at Mayfair Mall and was mobile in his vehicle in the parking lot at the time of this incident. Dispatch advised that the complainant, Mayfair Mall Security, stated five M/B subjects had caused a disturbance inside of the mall and that they would like the subjects removed from the property.

Complainant statement and initial observations

I made contact with Mayfair Security Director Travis NANCE (M/W [REDACTED]-1972) outside of entrance #10 to Mayfair Mall. NANCE stated he wanted me to make contact with the subjects and instruct them to vacate the property. NANCE stated the subjects were causing a disturbance near the Sprint kiosk inside of Mayfair Mall. NANCE stated the subjects were yelling obscenities and when NANCE made contact the subjects continued to yell obscenities before running away from security.

NANCE stated the subjects were last seen running in between vehicles in the west Macy's parking lot. Mayfair Mall Security's dispatch advised the subjects entered an unknown vehicle, possibly a Lincoln, and the vehicle began to vacate the parking lot. The subjects then immediately exited the unknown vehicle and began running southbound in the parking lot in between parked vehicles.

I observed Mayfair Mall Security Officer C [REDACTED] (M/W [REDACTED]-1995) running southbound from Crate & Barrel pointing southbound and yelling "That's them!". I observed the subjects running in between parked vehicles. I advised dispatch of their location. The subjects continued to run southbound between vehicles before turning to run westbound in the parking isle. The subjects had looked back at my fully marked Wauwatosa Police Squad numerous times.

Contact and arrest

I made contact with these same subjects by driving along side them and rolling down the driver's side window of my fully marked Wauwatosa Police squad vehicle. From my vehicle, I commanded them to stop several times. The subjects continued to walk at a fast pace westbound while looking back directly at me.

I continued to travel westbound in my fully marked Wauwatosa Police squad and

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continued to command the subjects to stop from my squad car. Several subjects, including a subject later identified as I [REDACTED] S [REDACTED] (M/B [REDACTED]-2000) ran to a parked silver Chevrolet Monte Carlo (WI Reg: AAZ4847). The two remaining subjects, later identified as J [REDACTED] I [REDACTED] (M/B [REDACTED]-2001) and I [REDACTED] C [REDACTED] (M/B [REDACTED]-2000) then began clenching their fists, elevating their arms and yelling things similar to "Fuck you! We didn't do nothin'! We don't have to stop!"

Due to this incident occurring on a Friday afternoon at approximately 4:37pm, Mayfair Mall was heavily populated with shopping patrons inside of the mall and outside in the parking lots surrounding the mall, including the surrounding parking lot where this incident occurred. There were many shopping patrons in direct listening and viewing distance of the disorderly subjects during this incident. I did not recognize the subjects from any prior interactions and I was not aware of their identities prior to this incident. I [REDACTED] and C [REDACTED] did not obey my commands for them to stop and continued to be extremely agitated and continued to walk away from me.

I exited my vehicle and instructed the subjects to stop several more times. I [REDACTED] stopped and quickly completed a shoulder shift to face me while walking, before continuing to walk westbound away from me. I instructed I [REDACTED] to stop again. I [REDACTED] clenched his fists, stiffened his arms and began yelling obscenities and said something similar to "I'm not going to stop because he didn't do nothin'!" I [REDACTED] then continued to walk away from me.

Due to I [REDACTED] failing to obey my lawful order, him fast approaching the silver Monte Carlo in an obvious attempt to flee the area and the threat of active resistance, I approached I [REDACTED] and placed my left hand on the outside of his right upper arm in an attempt to complete an escort hold and gain compliance and detain him. I was not aware if I [REDACTED] C [REDACTED] or S [REDACTED] had any concealed weapons on their persons at this time. I [REDACTED] immediately actively resisted by pulling his right arm away from me. I [REDACTED]'s arms were stiff and his hands were clenched at this time.

I informed I [REDACTED] that he was under arrest and blanketed his right arm in an attempt to place him into the come along position. I [REDACTED] resisted by attempting to pull his arm away from me. I then attempted a dynamic application of the hug yourself decentralization and was not successful due to I [REDACTED] becoming assaultive when he turned to face me and wrapped both of his arms around my waist and duty belt, which contained my duty firearm, a electronic control weapon, oleoresin capsicum spray (O.C. spray), ammunition, my flashlight and my handheld radio.

I [REDACTED] lowered his center and I felt my duty belt being pulled downwards towards the ground. I was unable to see I [REDACTED]'s hands at this time. I repeatedly instructed I [REDACTED] to get onto the ground. I [REDACTED] did not comply, continued to resist arrest and continued to be assaultive by wrapping his arms around my waist

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and duty belt and pulling downward.

I conducted a dynamic application of a decentralization by attempting to sweep I [REDACTED]'s legs with negative results. I [REDACTED] was planting his feet and was pushing with his body against mine which was causing us both to rotate.

At this time my handheld radio microphone became detached from the front of my external carrier and I was unable to notify dispatch that I [REDACTED] was resisting. There were no other Wauwatosa Police officers or Mayfair Security officers on scene at that time.

S [REDACTED] and C [REDACTED] continued to yell, had clenched fists, were raising their arms and were moving closer to me which made me fear for my safety. I believed a potential battery to myself was possible and imminent.

C [REDACTED] was directly behind me and to the left. I estimated that C [REDACTED] was within approximately ten feet of me. Numerous other unknown vehicles and subjects saturated the area and the subjects began yelling.

Mayfair Security Officer C [REDACTED] arrived on scene and attempted to assist and gain compliance of I [REDACTED] by controlling his arms and was not successful. At this time I was unable to reach for a control device and I did not wish to deploy an electronic control device, baton or O.C. spray as it would have potentially injured and disabled C [REDACTED], who was my only assisting unit at this time. C [REDACTED] was immediately behind me and it would not have been safely feasible to disengage and create enough distance to safely deploy an electronic control device or O.C. spray. It was also not safely feasible to deploy a control device due to the multiple subjects in my direct vicinity which posed a threat of disarmament, thus potentially escalating the use of force.

I [REDACTED] continued to actively resist and both C [REDACTED] and I were not successful in gaining compliance. I feared bodily harm to myself or C [REDACTED] was imminent and I feared for my safety.

Due to I [REDACTED]'s continued active resistance, assaultive behavior and my failure to successfully decentralize I [REDACTED] numerous times, I delivered a strong hand strike to I [REDACTED]'s face in an attempt to cease the assaultive behavior and gain control. I instructed I [REDACTED] to "get onto the ground" and immediately after the strike was delivered, C [REDACTED] and I were able to decentralize I [REDACTED] while attempting to control his descent and protect his head. I continued to command I [REDACTED] to place his hands behind his back. I [REDACTED]'s was not placing his hands behind his back. C [REDACTED] continued to move closer to me, which posed a threat. I instructed C [REDACTED] to back up numerous times.

I [REDACTED] actively resisted by pulling his arms away, clenching his fists and attempting to push himself up from the ground. I attempted to pull I [REDACTED]'s left hand behind his back with negative results. C [REDACTED] also attempted to pull I [REDACTED]'s

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right arm behind his back with negative results. I placed my right hand to the upper shoulders and to the back of I [REDACTED]'s neck in an attempt to counter his pushing up motion. I [REDACTED]'s continued to resist and push his body up off of the ground.

Due to I [REDACTED]'s continued resistance and threat of continued assaultive behavior, I delivered a strong hand strike to the right side of I [REDACTED]'s face with a target area of the right ear, in order to cause a dysfunction and gain compliance. Immediately after the strike was delivered I [REDACTED] placed his hands behind his back and C [REDACTED] and I were able to place I [REDACTED] into handcuffs. I was then able to notify dispatch that I [REDACTED] was resisting, that we were taking him into custody and to dispatch additional officers.

PO Akins arrived on scene and assisted with searching I [REDACTED] incident to arrest. I [REDACTED] continued to resist and began kicking his legs towards me. I held I [REDACTED]'s legs down briefly and told him to stop resisting. I did not locate anything illegal on I [REDACTED] at that time.

I [REDACTED] was placed into my squad car to await transport to the Wauwatosa Police Department for processing. I asked I [REDACTED] if he required any medical assistance. I [REDACTED] stated he did not wish for medical assistance, was not injured and was not in pain. I [REDACTED] did not have any visible injuries.

During this incident C [REDACTED] suffered a small laceration to his right hand and did not request medical attention and stated he did not give I [REDACTED] consent to cause him pain and is willing to aid in prosecution. I received a laceration to my left knee that caused me pain and my patrol pants sustained a tear in the left knee area. I did not wish for medical attention. Digital photographs were taken of our injuries and were uploaded to the secured server to be attached to this case.

NANCE pointed to I [REDACTED] and stated he was the subject who primarily caused the disturbance inside of Mayfair Mall at the Sprint kiosk. NANCE stated I [REDACTED] was yelling obscenities and being very loud. NANCE wished for prosecution of I [REDACTED] and did not give him consent to be disorderly. S [REDACTED] and C [REDACTED] were issued bans by Mayfair Mall Security. S [REDACTED] and C [REDACTED] were then released from the scene with verbal warnings and were advised to vacate the property. S [REDACTED] and C [REDACTED] made comments that they were going to return to the scene.

C [REDACTED] was on juvenile probation for resisting or obstructing an officer and receiving or concealing stolen property during this incident. I later contacted C [REDACTED]'s agent, Ada Grice to inform them of this incident and left a voice message. C [REDACTED] has a criminal history that includes: Armed robbery, Operate a vehicle without owner's consent, battery, criminal damage to property and theft.

S [REDACTED] had a criminal history prior to this incident that included armed robbery, robbery, battery, criminal damage to property, retail theft and escape.

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I [REDACTED] was transported to the Wauwatosa Police Department for processing.

I [REDACTED] was calm at this point and stated he apologized for his actions.

Booking and citations

I [REDACTED] was booked, finger printed and photographed without incident. PO Akins assisted with the booking process.

I [REDACTED] had a criminal history prior to this incident that included criminal damage to property.

I explained the citations to I [REDACTED] and provided him copies for his records. I [REDACTED] stated he apologized for his actions, that he understood why force was used and that he should have stopped when instructed. I [REDACTED] also stated the he had purchased a \$30 item from Victoria Secret and had lost it while running through the parking lot and that he was upset due to that happening.

Parental contact

I made phone contact with I [REDACTED]'s mother, T [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] (F/B [REDACTED]-1981), who stated she was out of town at the time of this incident. I informed M [REDACTED] of the incident and explained that I [REDACTED] would be receiving three municipal citations and that he did not request any medical attention. M [REDACTED] was apologetic for her son's actions, thanked me and provided me consent to transport him to his residence as his grandmother was watching him while she was gone.

I transported I [REDACTED] to Mayfair Mall where he was issued a ban by Mayfair Mall Security. I [REDACTED] was then provided a courtesy conveyance to his residence located at [REDACTED] without incident. I [REDACTED] again stated he apologized, that he should have stopped and understood why force was used. I [REDACTED] stated "I got you man. I will be truthful with everyone when I get home and let them

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know it was my fault".

I made brief contact with I [REDACTED]'s grandmother and observed I [REDACTED] enter the residence.

NARRATIVE**INITIAL CALL:**

On Friday May 11, 2018 at approximately 1637 hours, I, Officer Daniel Akins, responded to Mayfair Mall, 2500 N. Mayfair Rd. for a report of a 4-5 m/b subjects causing a disturbance in the mall.

P.O. Evan Olson advised that the subjects were running s/b through the parking lot from Crate and Barrel. At that point, P.O. Olson clicked his radio, however there was nothing said over the radio. Wauwatosa Police Dispatch attempted to contact P.O. Olson, but he did not respond.

ARREST:

I observed one Mayfair Mall security vehicle between Boston Store and Cheesecake Factory. I drove to the area and located P.O. Olson who had a subject, later identified as J [REDACTED] I [REDACTED] (m/b [REDACTED]/2001) on the ground and handcuffed. I went to assist P.O. Olson as it appeared that I [REDACTED] was attempting to stand up and was kicking his feet back toward P.O. Olson.

I kneeled next to I [REDACTED]'s upper body area and placed my hands between his shoulders to control his upper body. I [REDACTED] continued to resist and tense his upper body and was attempting to stand up. I [REDACTED] was agitated and was screaming profanities. P.O. Olson completed a search incident to arrest and we assisted I [REDACTED] to stand up and escorted him to P.O. Olson's squad car. Throughout the entire time, I [REDACTED] was yelling profanities and tensing his arms.

Once inside the squad car, I [REDACTED] calmed down and stated he was sorry for his actions.
